
## Talking Card




What better than a card with a moving mouth? Whilst we have made ours for Valentine's Day you can do them for any occasion!

Tools and Materials:



- Pritt Stick
- Colouring Pencils
- A2 Paper
- Scissors





Although we used A2 paper if you don't have any you could use 2 sheets of A4, with our A2 paper that is enough to create 2 cards. Fold your paper in half and then cut it following the line you have scored with your thumb or scissors




Then fold one of the bits in half again and cut into 2 bits, the bits you end up with after this are the same as A4 so if you are using A4 you can start following from the next stage!




Fold in half again to make the card, do this with both bits you have just cut to size (or if you have 2 A4 fold them in half)




Now to make the mouth, take one of your bits of paper (the other is going to be the back of your card) and roughly in the middle cut a straight line roughly the same length as your scissor blades (about 5cm long)




This is the “trickiest” bit of the card and it isn’t too tricky once you have got it! Once you have cut down it should look like so




Fold the flaps back to make triangles, do this for both flaps and score them down with the scissors




So not only do you do it for both flaps but you need to fold them over on both sides, this is to make your mouth movable




It's important to score on both sides so you end up with your paper looking like this when it is opened up





To make the mouth push the paper through, do this on the inside of the card - you can tell from the fold, much like a book the inside is where you have to open it to see it



Pinch the mouth at the point to make it more mouth shaped, do this for both bits the upper and lower “lips”



Now you can start your design! Remember the square you can see on the paper is the whole of the mouth so just think about that when doing your design



Stick your "mouth" card to the plain card to make the whole of the card and then decorate the front and back if you want, don't forget to colour inside the mouth! There you have it your Talking Card!
