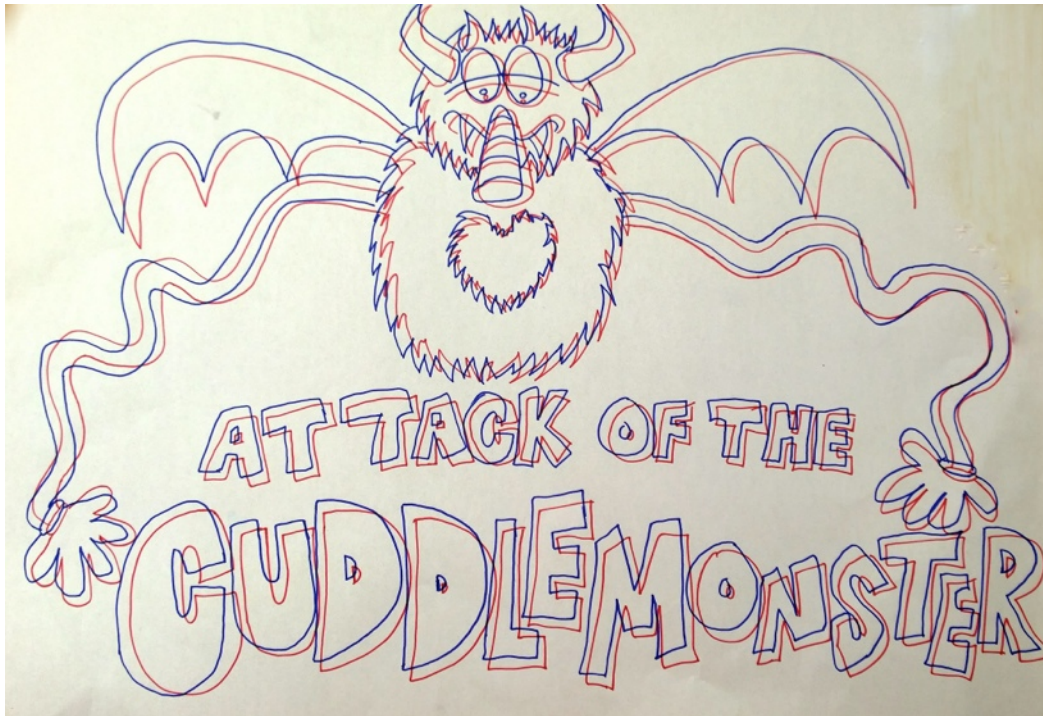


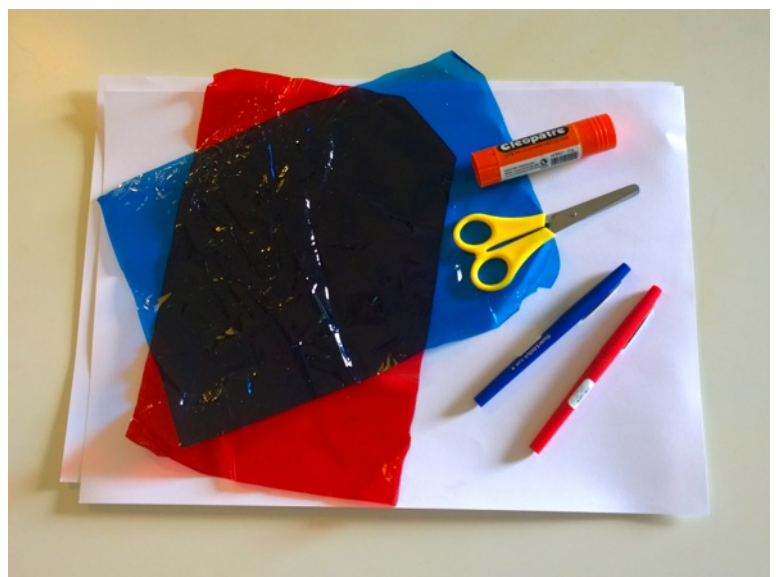
3D Drawings a.k.a Anaglyphs



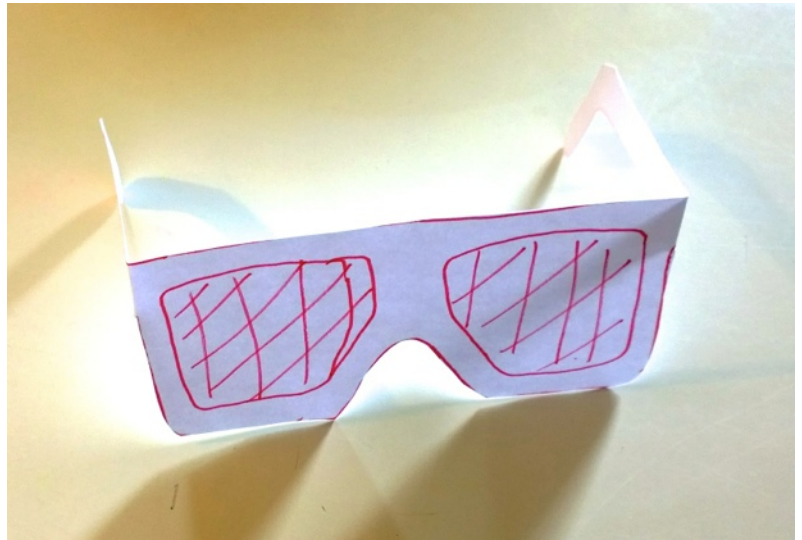
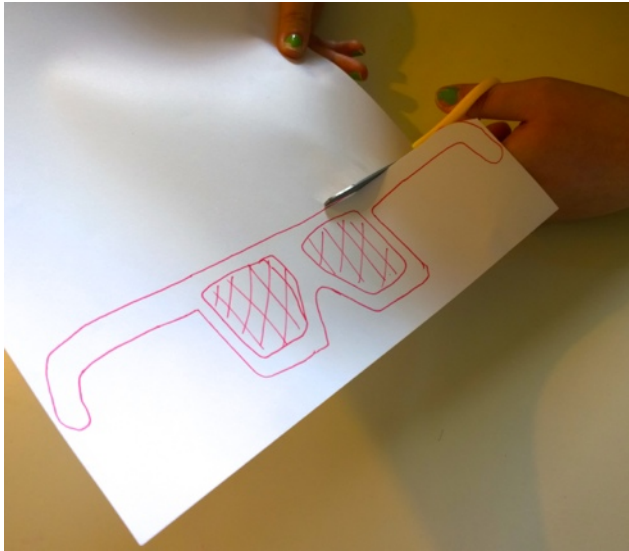
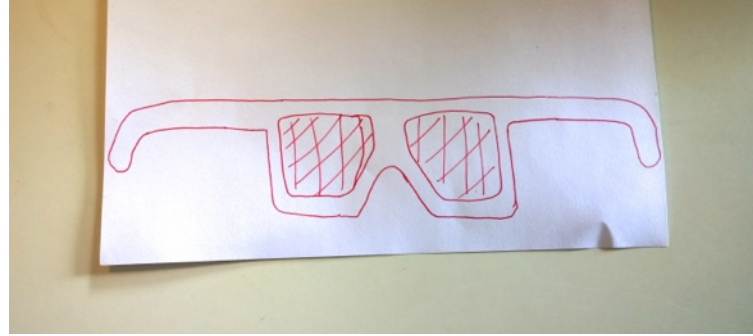
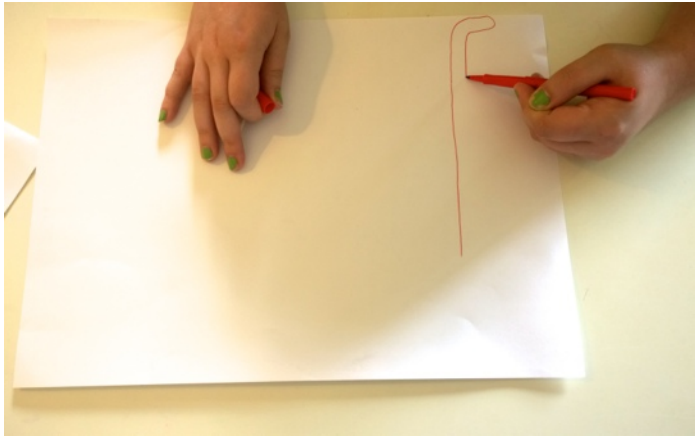
This is a really easy way to make your own 3D drawings!

Tools and Materials:

- Paper
- Scissors
- Pritt Stick
- Red Pen
- Blue Pen
- Blue Cellophane
- Red Cellophane



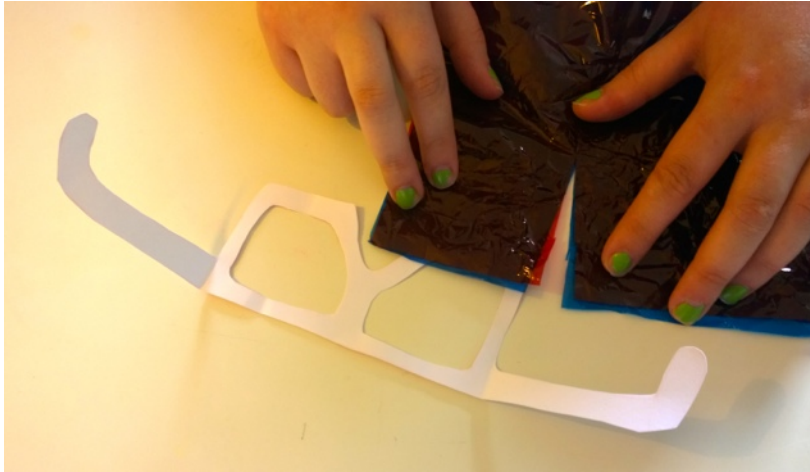
Firstly you can create your glasses so you can see your drawings! Draw out a rough glasses shapes - make sure the glasses bit is wide enough to fit your face!



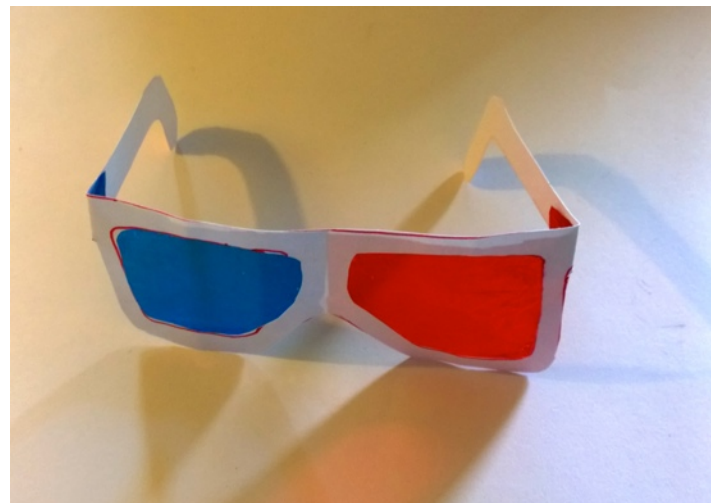
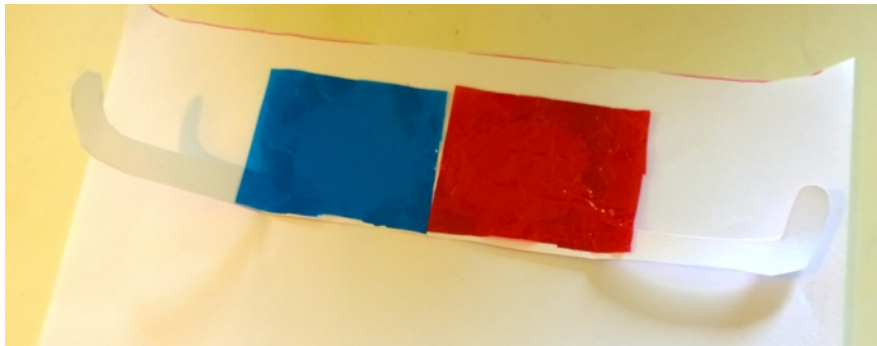
Now to cut out the eyeholes, the easiest way to do this is to fold it in half to cut out the middle of the glasses



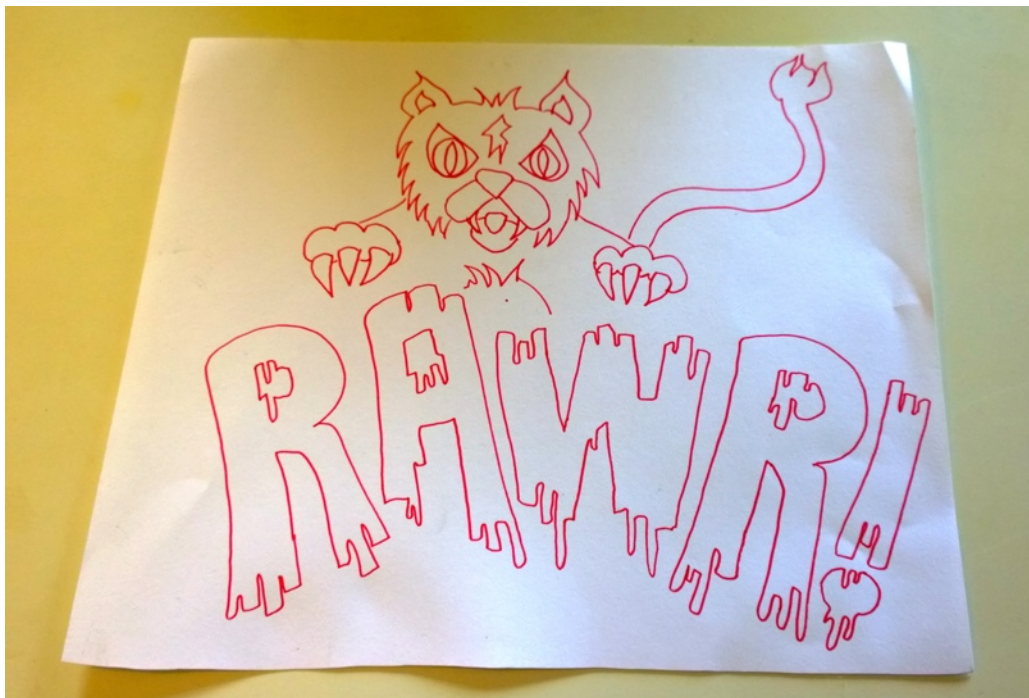
Once you have your frames we can create the lenses, you need one square of each colour - make sure the red goes in the left eye, the blue in the right. One cut out glue the squares on



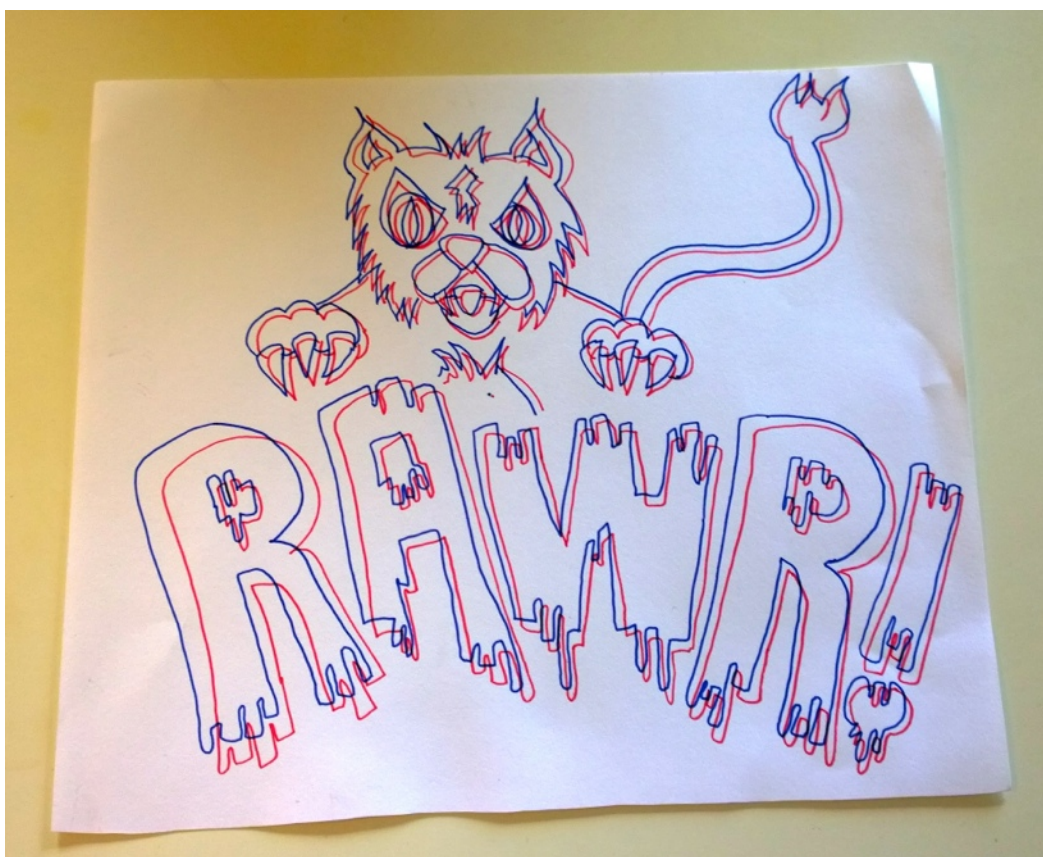
Once glued on you can trim around the glasses to neaten it up



Now to draw your image! Start with your red pen to create your drawing, simple line drawings work better for this type of project.



Now you can add your blue lines, you want to copy your drawing in red but every line slightly up and to the left of your original lines like so
