Design your own Board Game



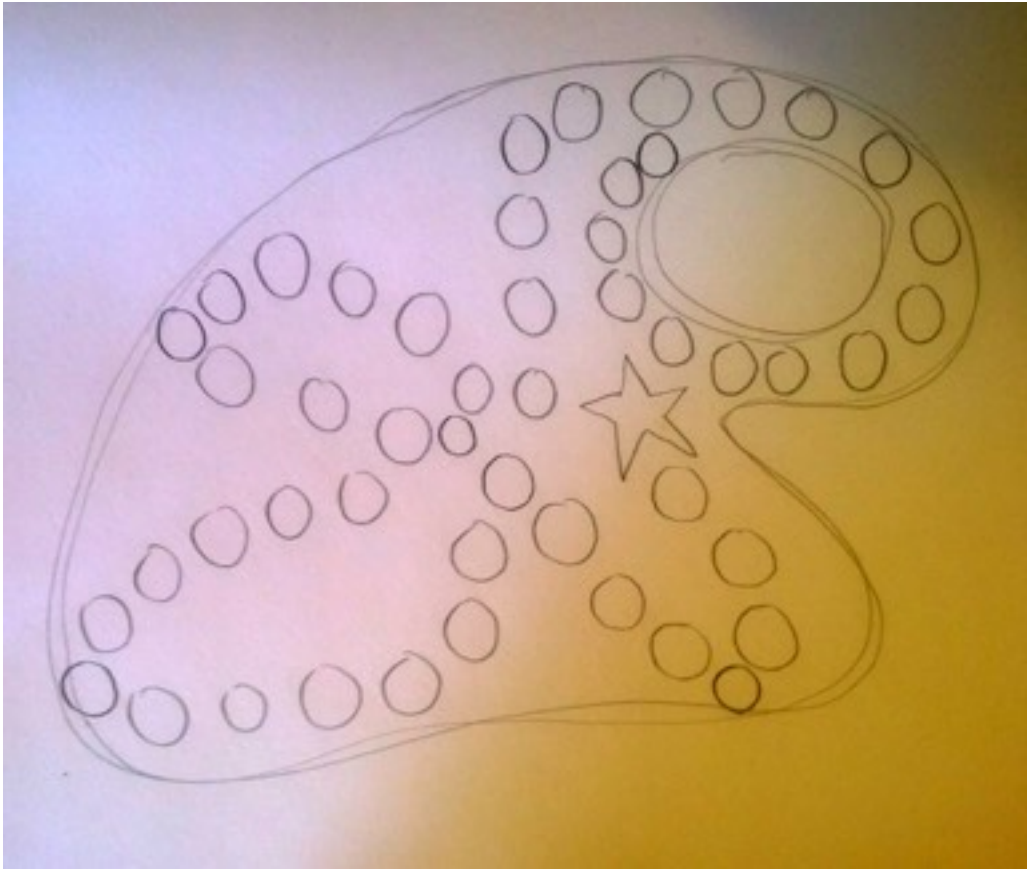
Taking inspiration from “Game & Puzzle Week” which falls in the third week of November - why not create your own board game!

We are basing our game on the colours of the rainbow and having to get one of each colour therefore we had to have 49 circles plus a start and an end place

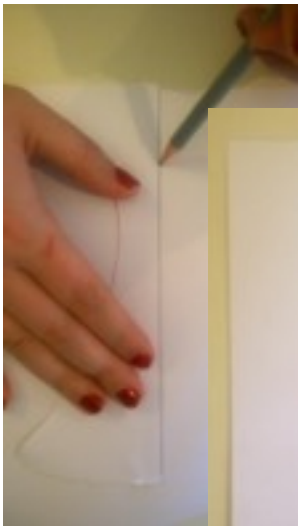


Then you can start colouring it in once you have figured your board out and cut it out

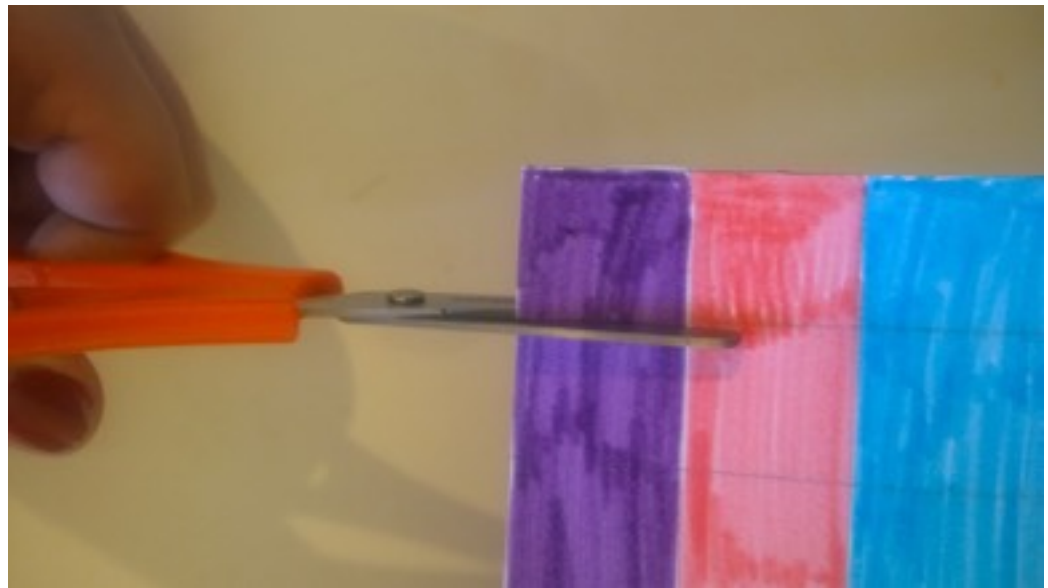
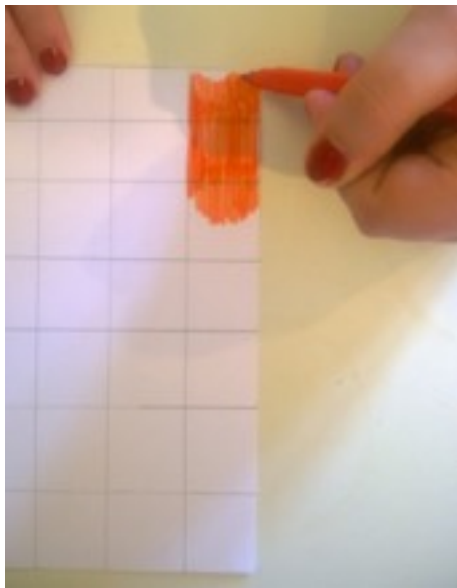




Once you sorted out your board what else do you need to make your game work? We are creating colour question counters - using your papers straight edge as a ruler you can draw squares for your cards like so



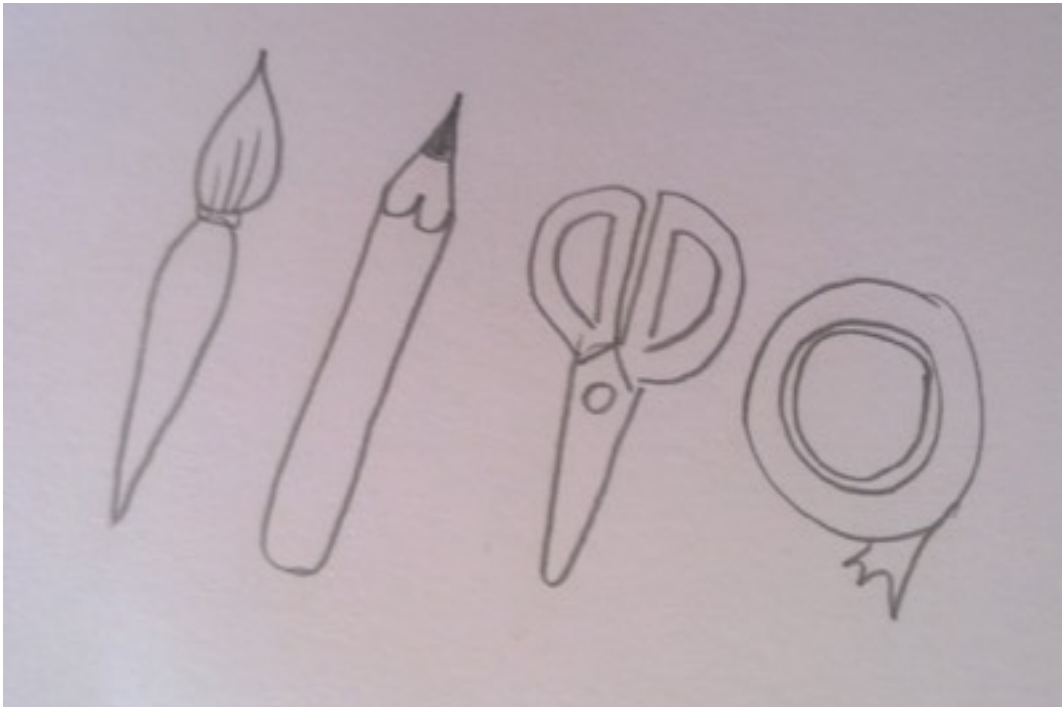
Colour in your squares and then cut them out



Then the trickiest bit is coming up with the questions - we chose questions relating to the different colours such as name an animal or fruit that is that colour or what song or book has the colour in the title, what colours make other colours and even how they are spelt!



Create your counters to move around with - following an art theme we choose items we use all the time in class!
