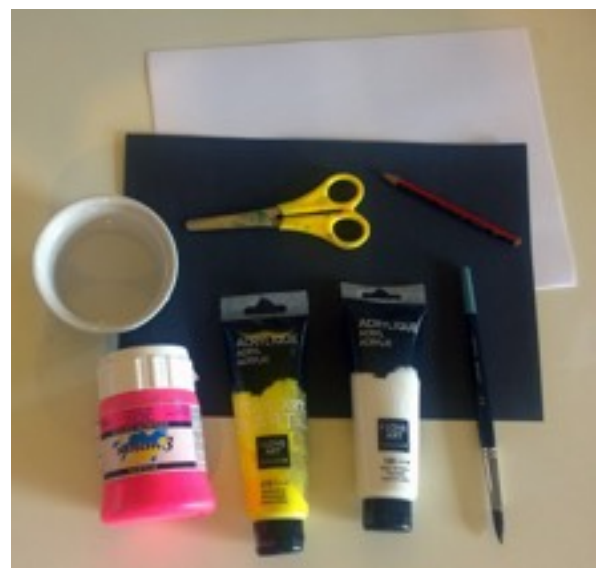
Flick Paintings



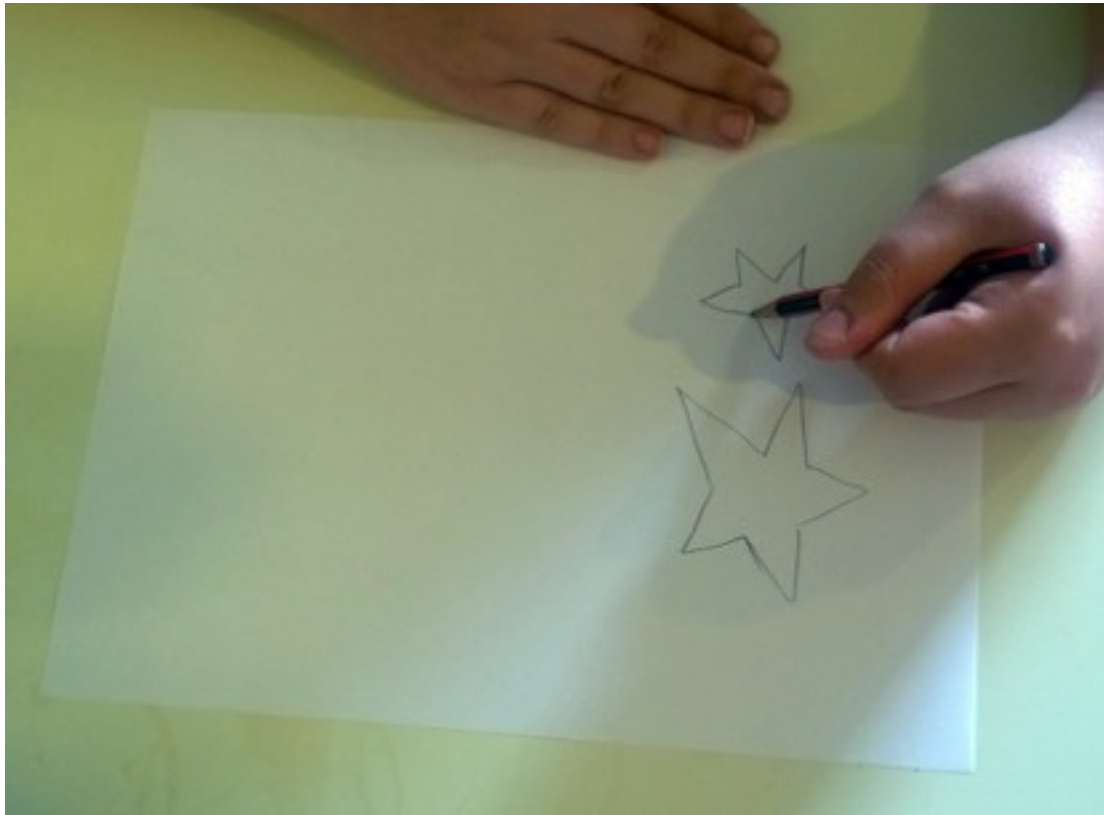
Flick paintings are so much fun but super messy so might be better done outside if possible and definitely with newspaper down on the ground!

Tools and Materials:

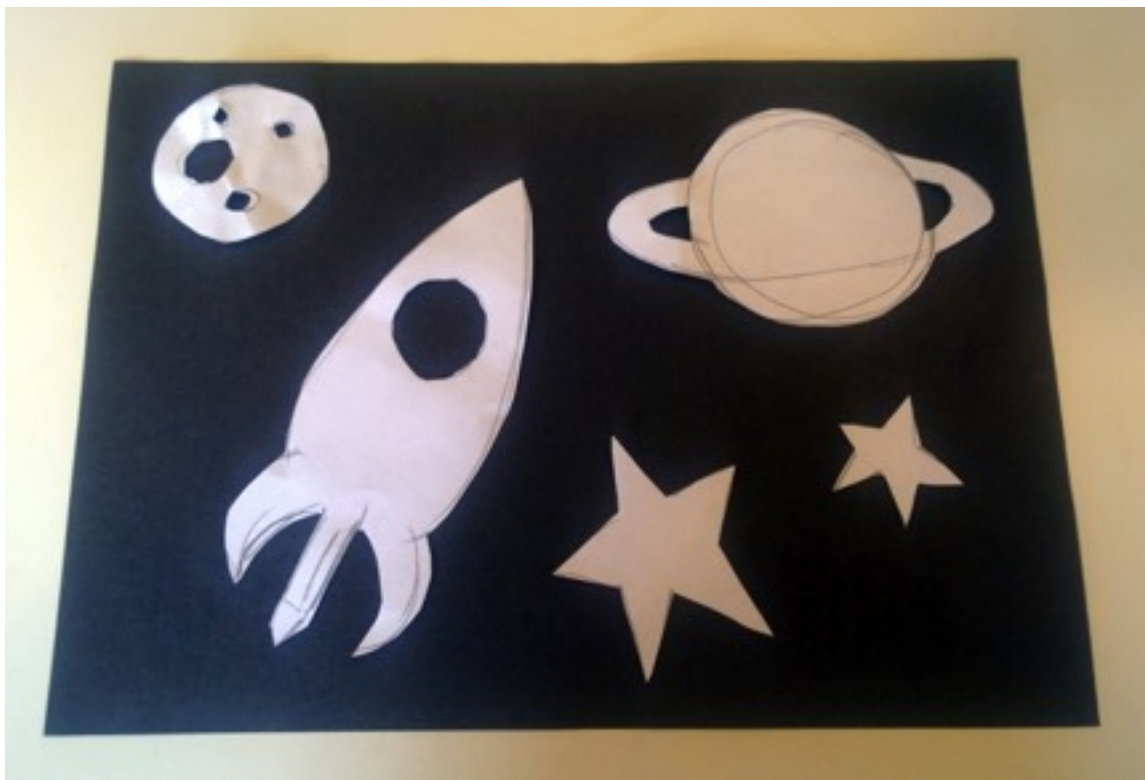
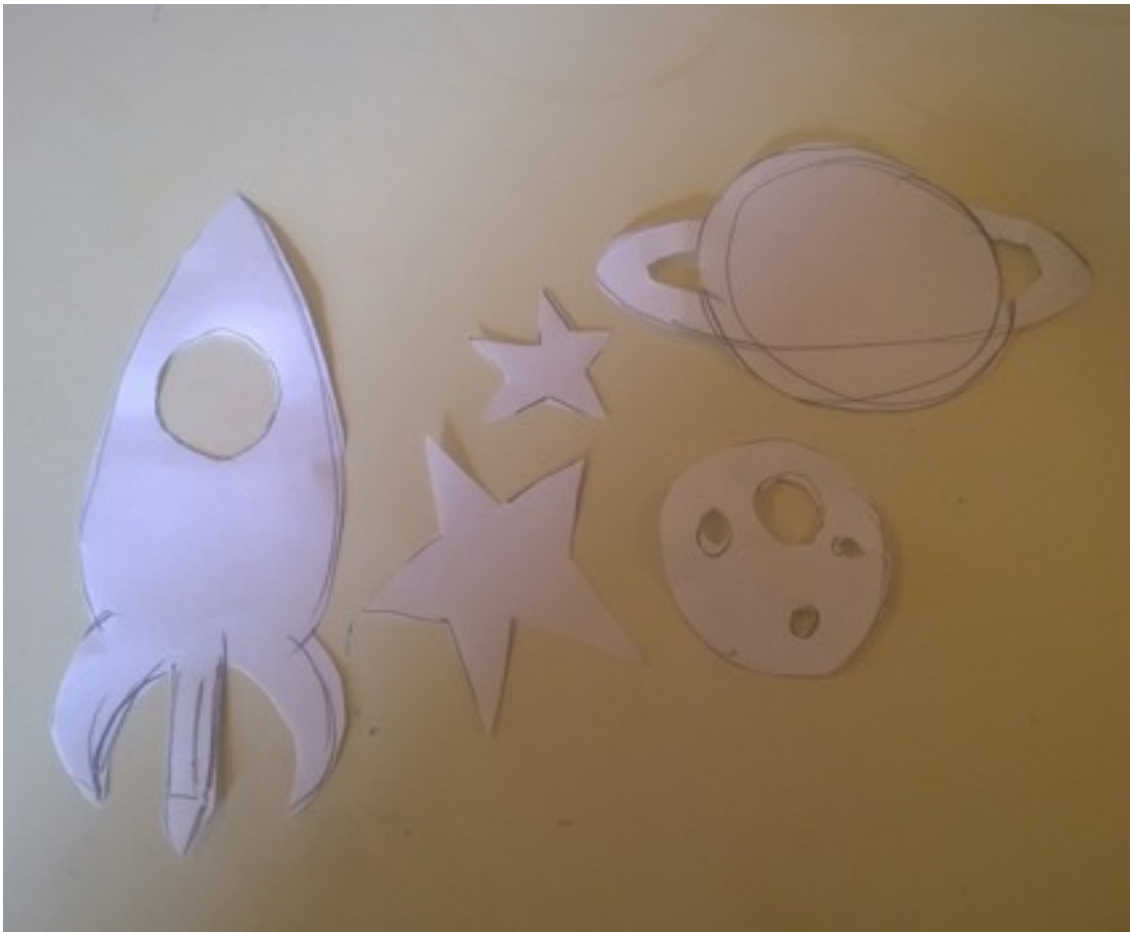
- Pencil
- Acrylic/Poster Paint diluted with water
- Paintbrush or Old Toothbrush
- White & Black Paper
- Scissors
- Newspaper to protect the surfaces!!



First you need to draw out your stencils - we chose to do a space theme so stars, planets and rocket!



Once you are happy with your stencils you can cut them out - and then arrange them on your black paper to create your flick painting artwork



Now for the messy bit!! Make sure you have put down lots and lots of newspaper - don't forget the paint will flick not just down to the paper but also up so be careful of walls and ceilings as you don't want them spotted with paint!



Once you are happy it has enough paint on you can start to peel your stencils off - if your paint is really watery leave it to dry for a bit first so is easier to remove from the paper



And there you have it your very own flick painting
