## Mono-printing



This is a really easy way to do print-making , anyone can do it and end up with pretty cool results!

Tools and Materials:

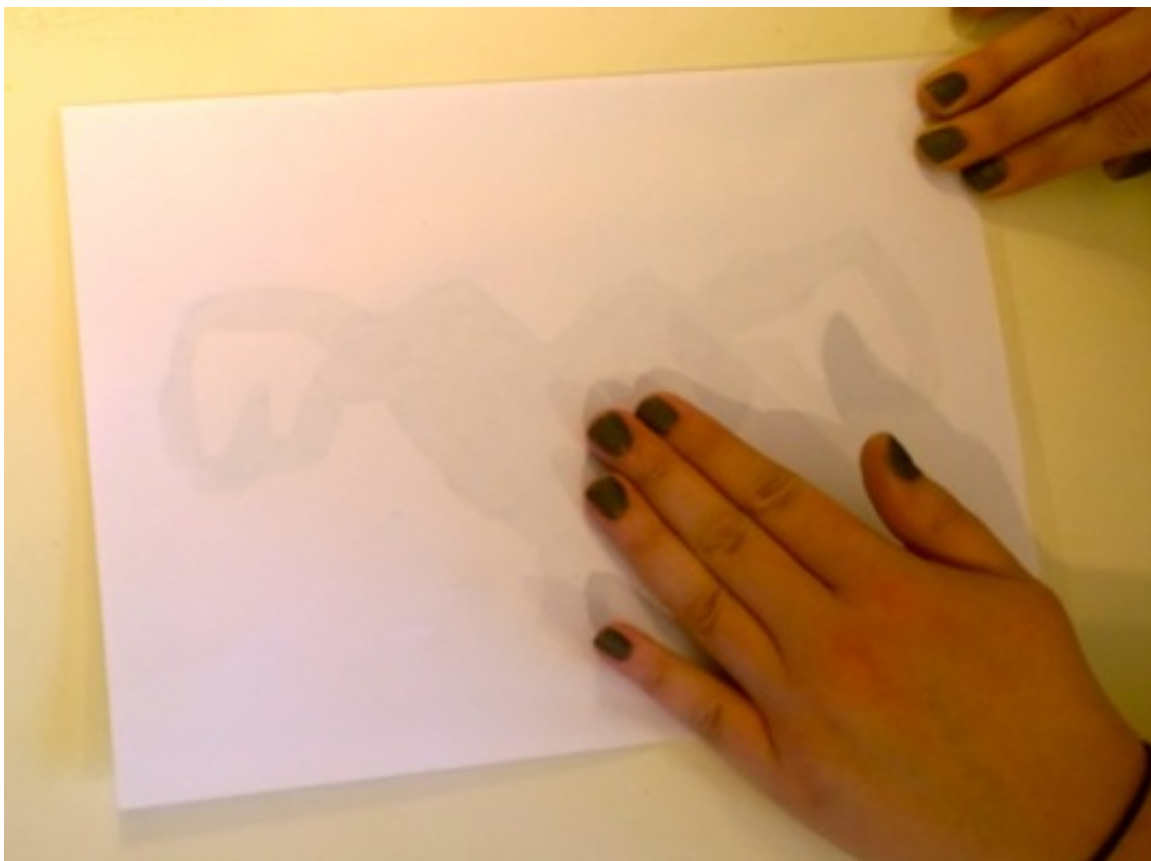
- Paper
- Paintbrush
- Acrylic Paint
- Acetate or any solid plastic surface you might have that you are allowed to use!



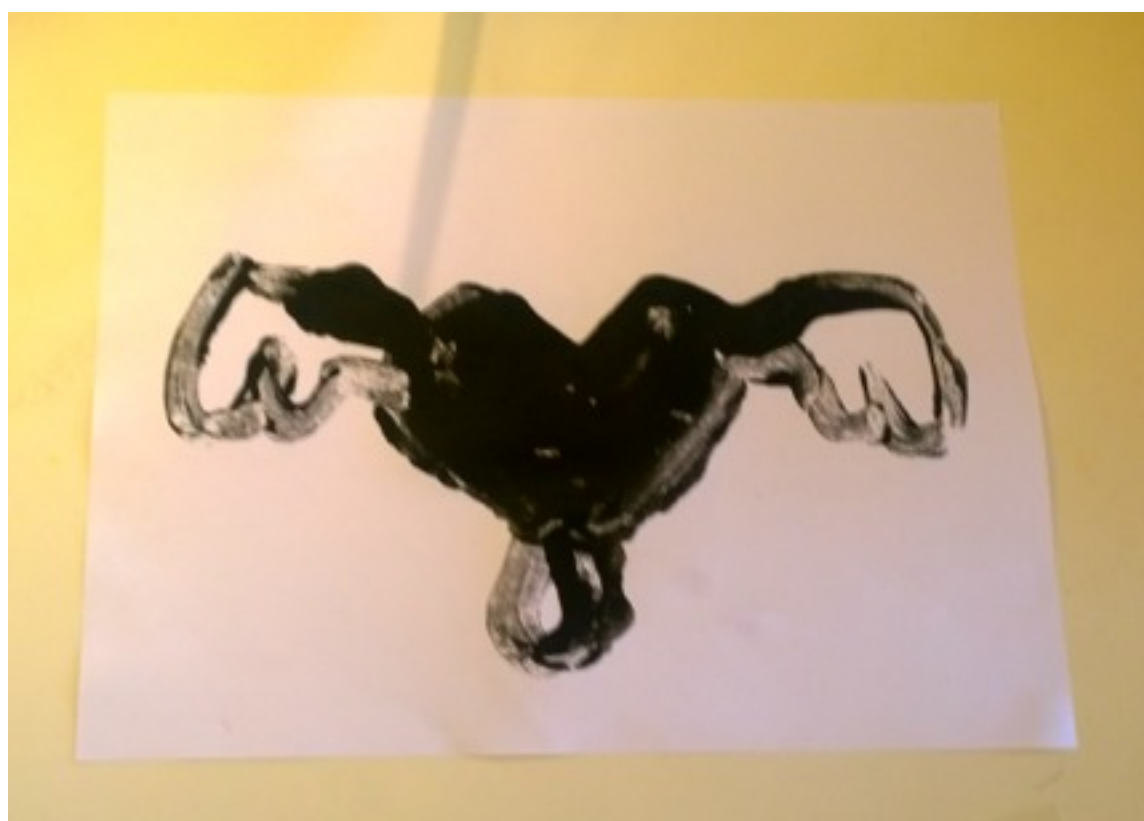
There are two ways to mono-print with acetate firstly you can paint the image directly onto it like we will show you now. Paint whatever you like onto the acetate - just remember if you are doing text it is backward so practice first to make sure!



When you are happy with your image place your paper on top and gently smooth it to make sure it touches all the parts of your painted image



Then peel your paper back to reveal your print!



The second way to do a mono-print is to cover the acetate in paint and then draw into it with the end of your paintbrush to create your image - again remember it will be backwards on the acetate to paint the right way on the paper!
