“Pop Art”



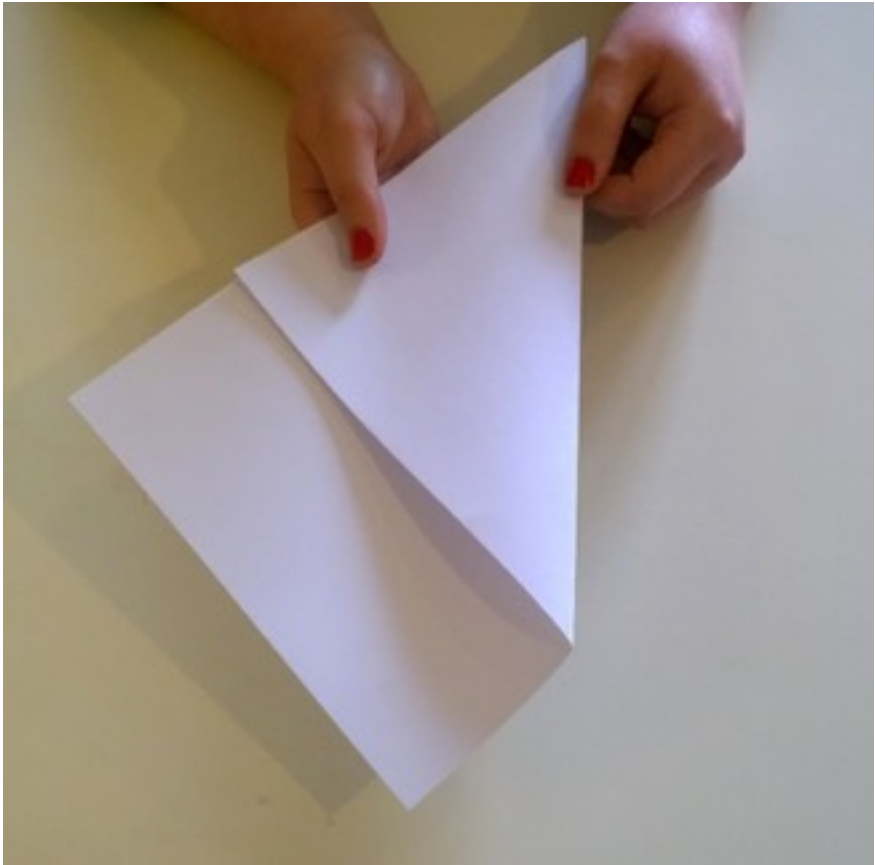
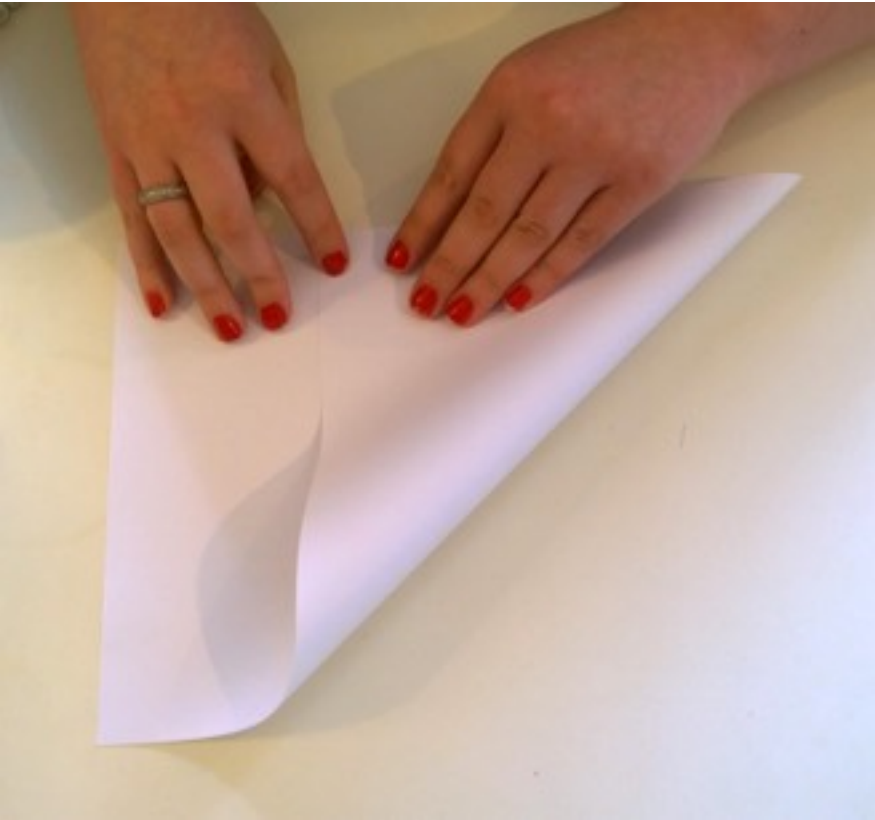
Taking inspiration from Warhol and his screen prints you can create your own colour changing artworks

Tools and Materials:

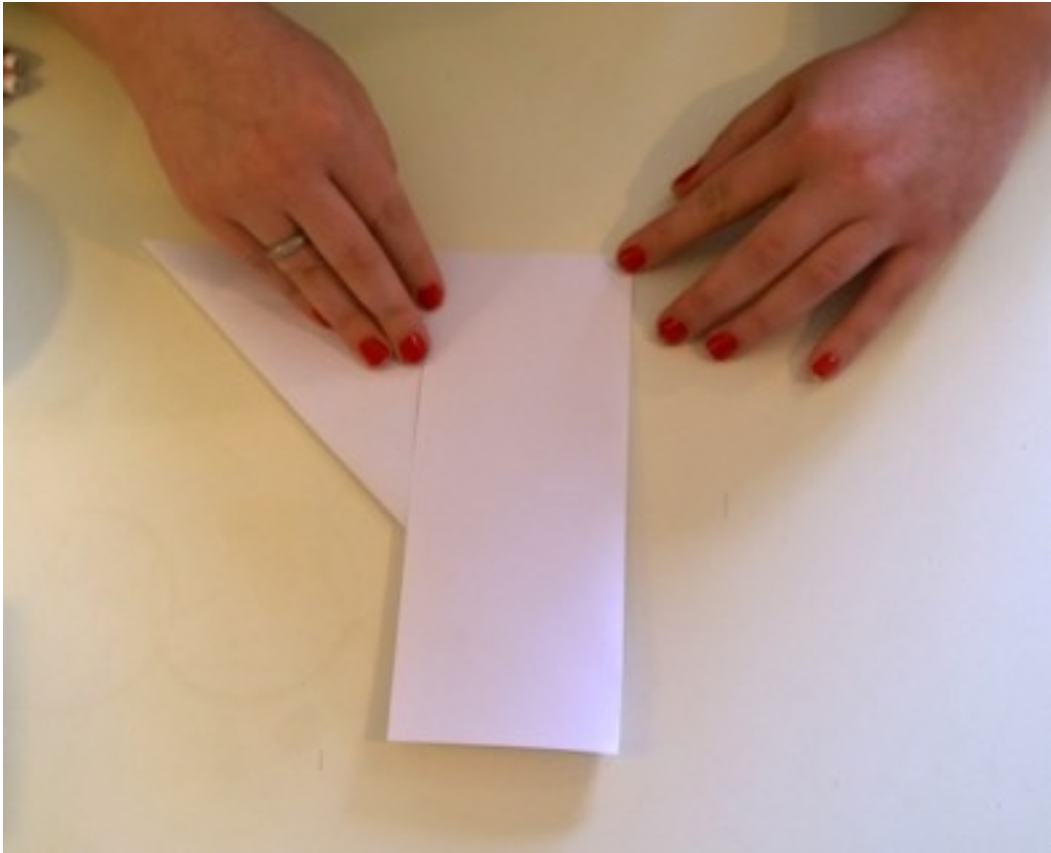
- Felt Tips
- A4 Paper



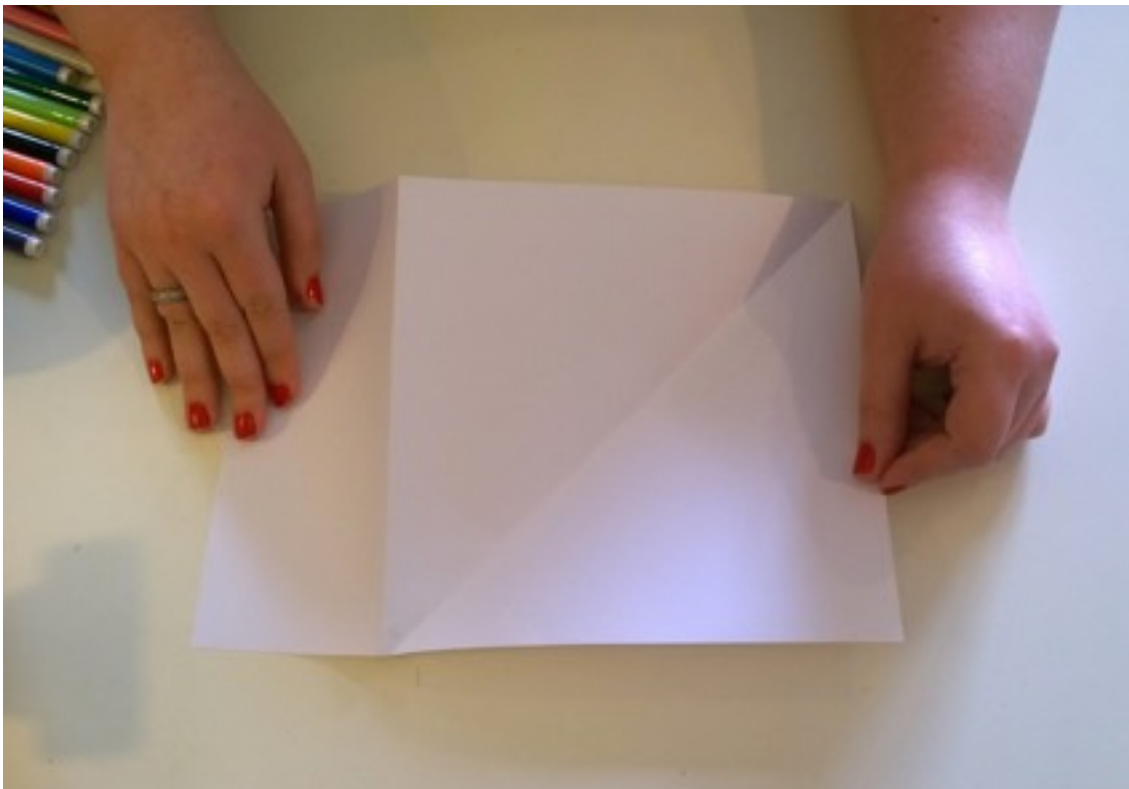
First of all we want to make the paper into a square shape, to do this take the top corner and fold it over to touch the bottom side - forming a triangle shape like so



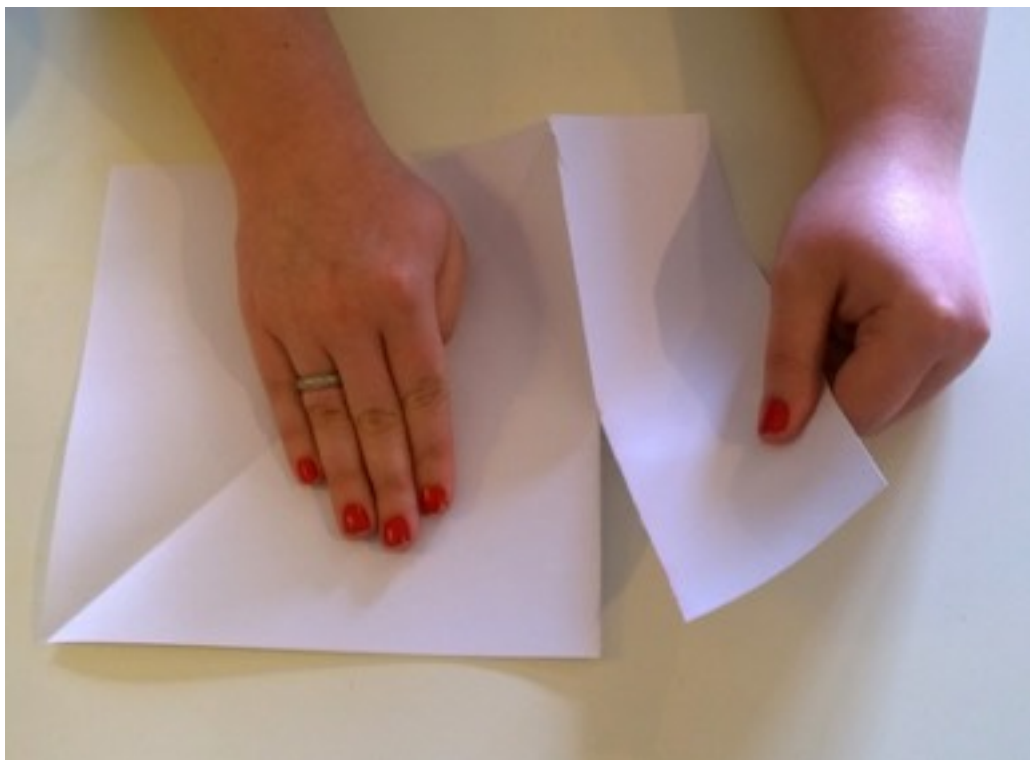
Now with the excess rectangle on the edge of the triangle fold it over and crease it to create a line



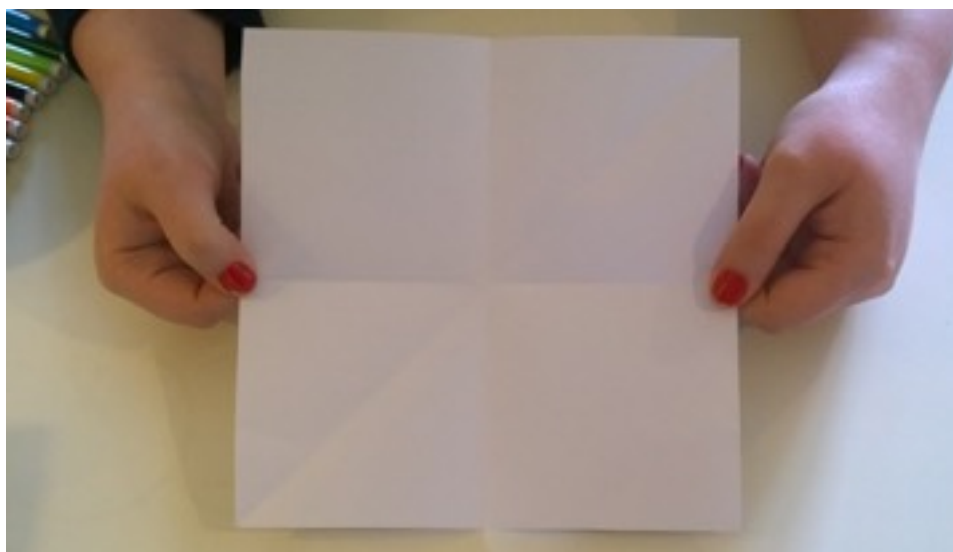
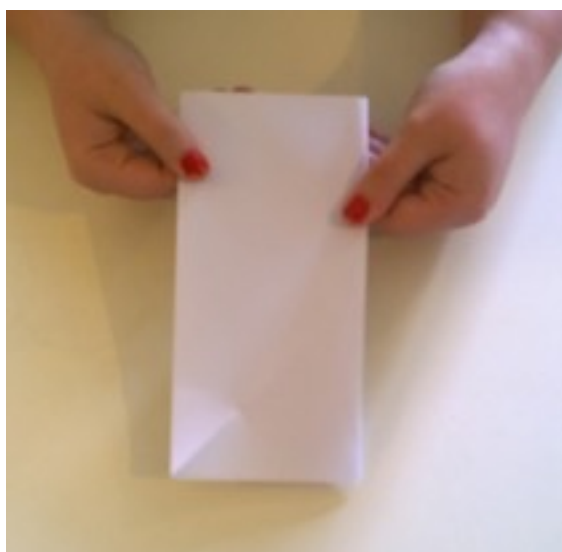
Your paper should end up looking like this



If you have scored the line hard enough you should be able to tear it off - if you want you can always use scissors!



Now you have your square fold it in half one way, open it up and fold in half the other way to create 4 equal squares - also known as quarters



As there are four sections of your page we found it good to choose four colours to create an image four different elements - to make it easier for the colour change



Now the fun bit - choosing what to draw, don't forget to do something easy enough to repeat



Now you can repeat your image - shifting the colours one place to make sure they are used in each position



And there you have it your own Pop Art inspired piece!
