Rocket



Anytime of year is fun to create rockets - but especially Bonfire Night on the 5th November

Tools and Materials:

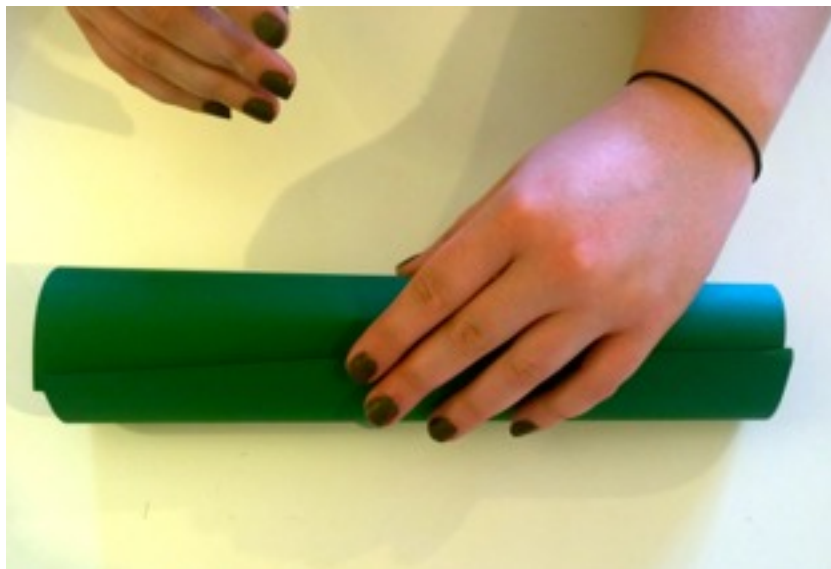
- Coloured Paper
- Plain Paper
- Felt Tips
- Pencil
- Sellotape
- Scissors



First you want to cut some strips of sellotape and put them on your hand or the edge of the table so they are ready to put on the rocket - as it can be a bit tricky to hold it in place



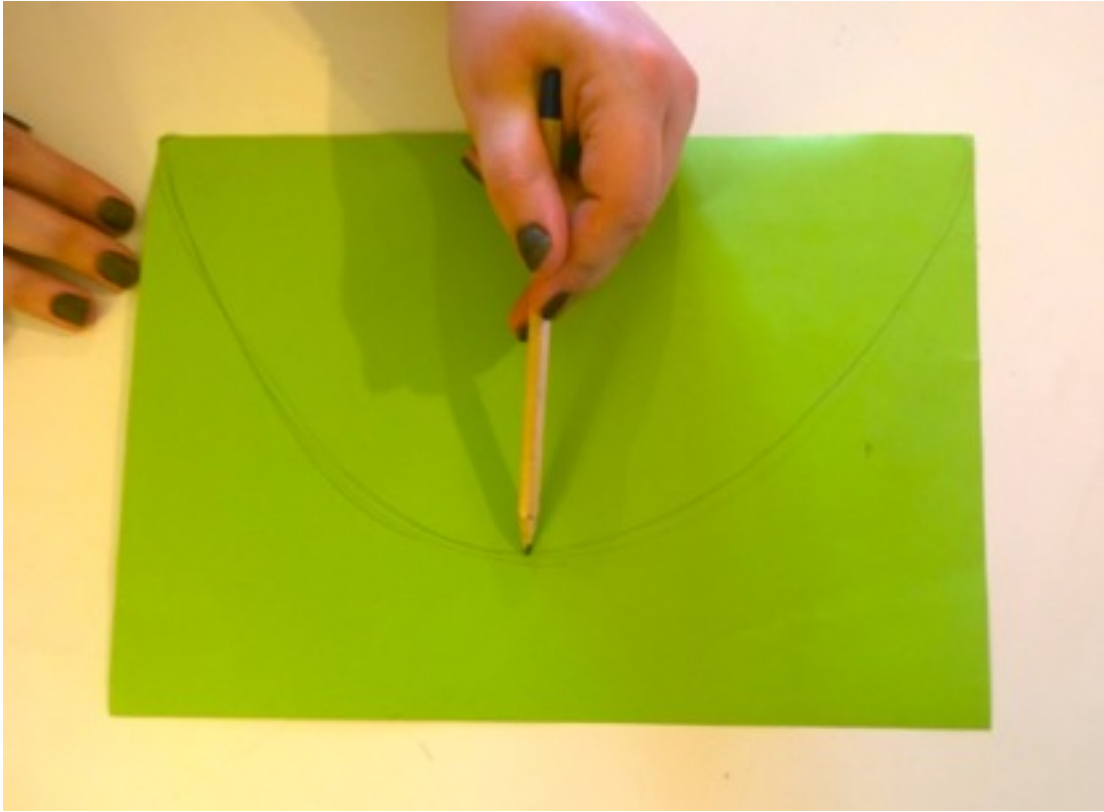
Roll one of your pieces of coloured paper into a tube - it is best done along the short side so you get a long rocket plus it is easier to make a point for!



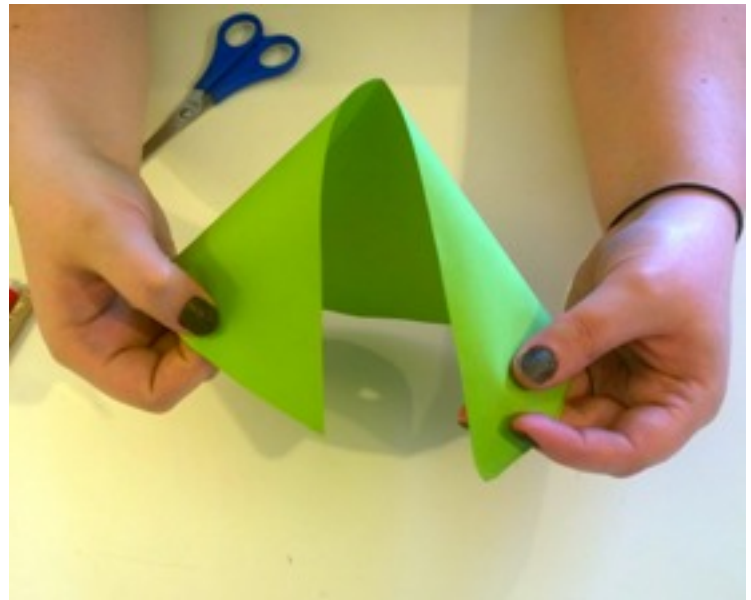
If you secure it with a few bits of tape then you can put a longer bit of tape on to keep it in place better



Now to make the top of your rocket - get a piece of paper the same size as your rocket body, we used A4 and draw a rough semi circle - it doesn't have to be perfect you can trim it later!



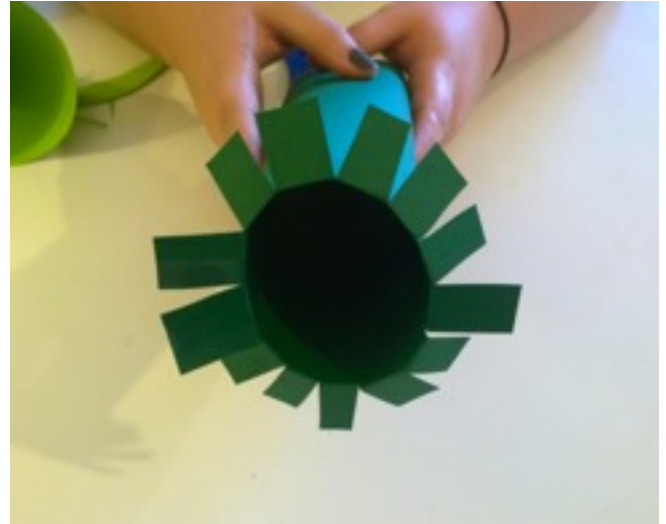
Cut it out and then fold the straight side in half to make a pyramid shape - this will be the point of your rocket



When you are happy with the point on the tip of your rocket then you can tape it and trim it so the base is more rounded



Now to attach the point to your rocket's body, trim all around one end making cuts 1-2cm long like so



Now you can fit the bent back tabs into the head of the rocket and use sellotape to secure it - you may want to ask a friend to help you hold and tape it as it is a little tricky!



Now you can create the decorations for your rocket on the plain paper, draw and cut it ready to stick on - we used loops of tape to give it a more 3D effect



There you have it - your very own "Rocket"
