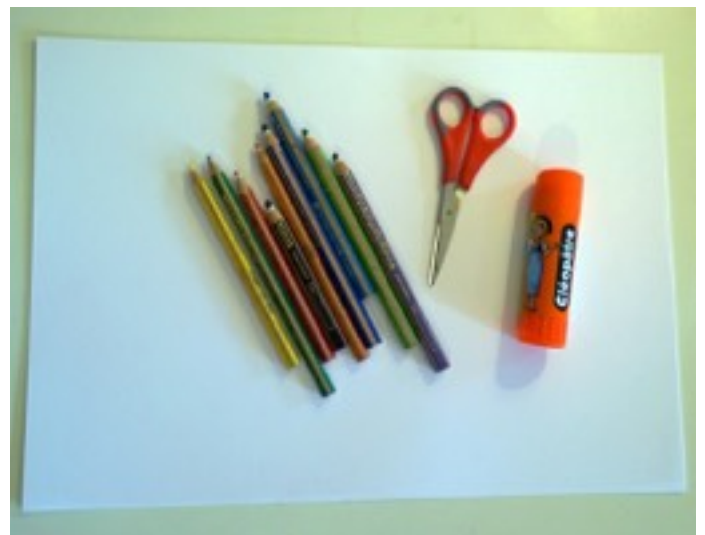
Moving Stories



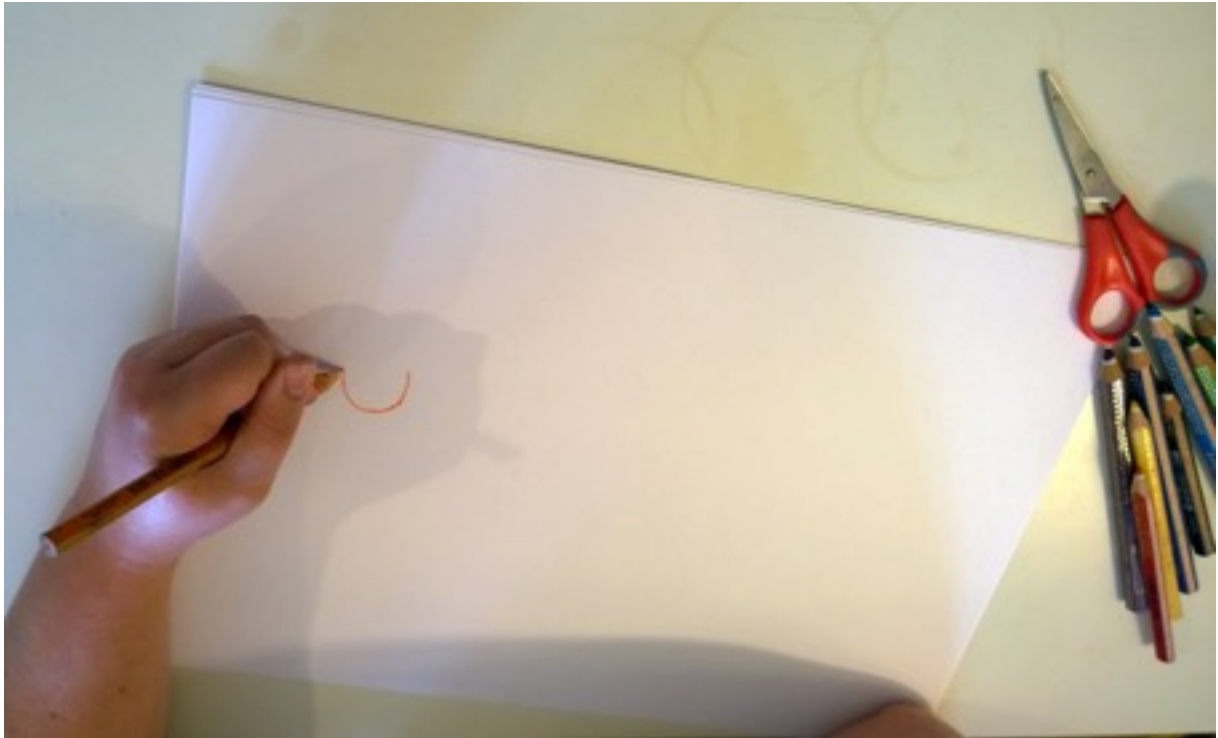
Based on your favourite stories of old or even your own narrative you can create characters and backgrounds to tell your story

Tools and Materials:

- Colouring Pencils
- Scissors
- Pritt Stick
- Card (A3 if possible)



First you need to come up with your characters - is it a story you have already read or one you have made up?



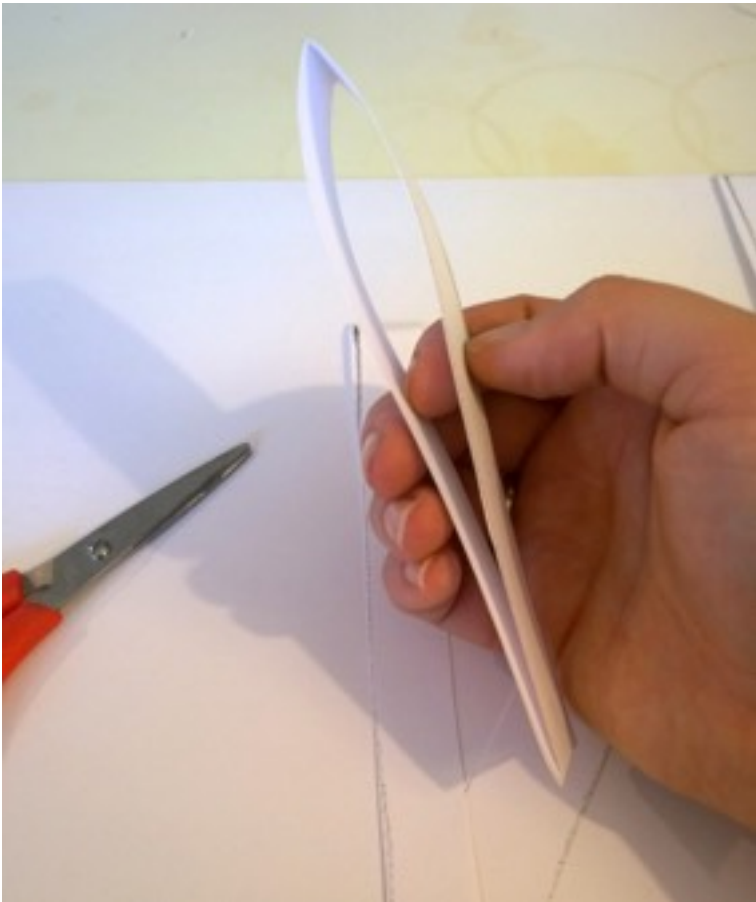
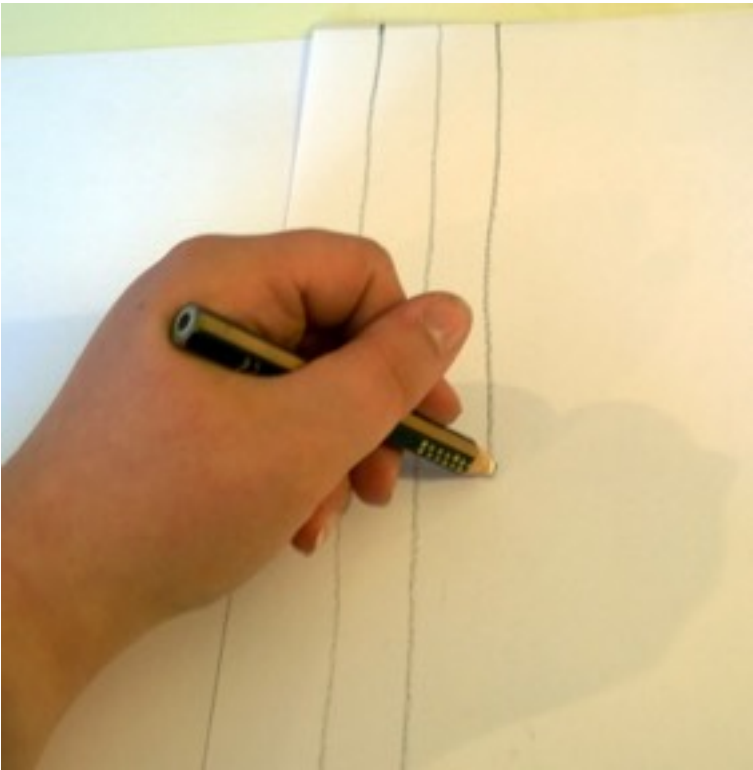
Once you have decided - draw out your characters and colour them in - you can always add more characters for different scenes in your story



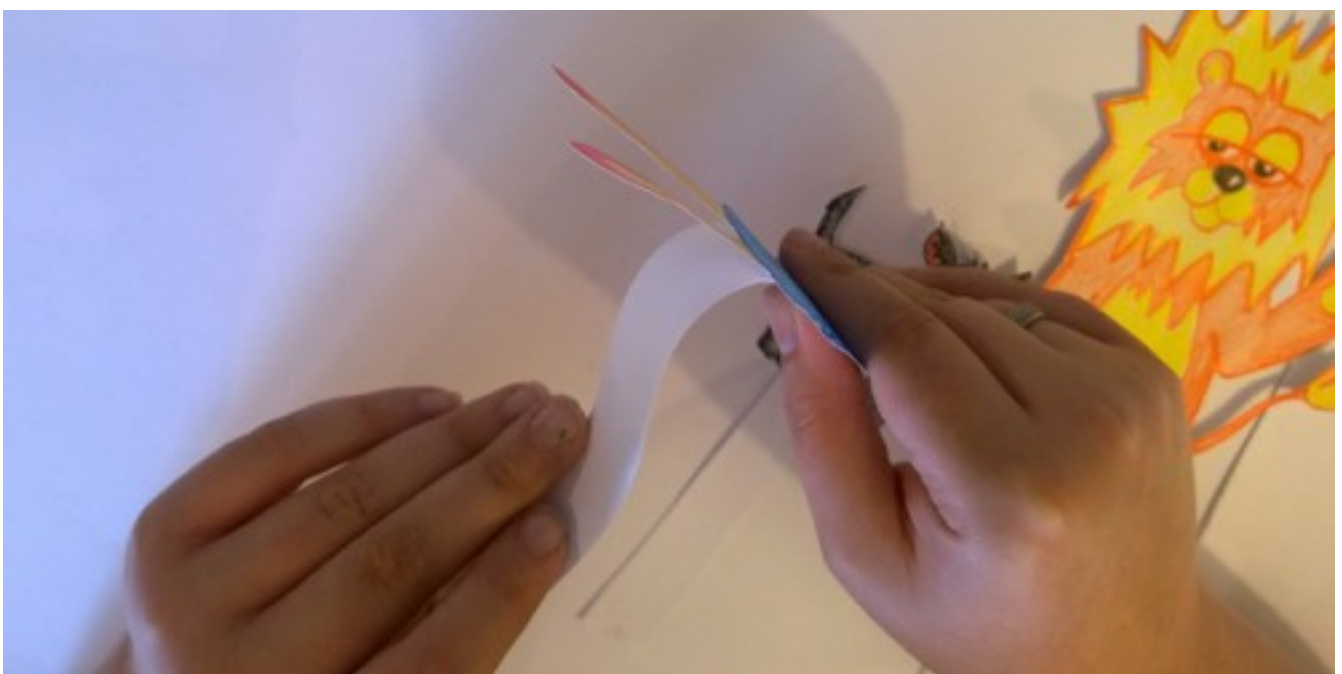
So when you are you done with your characters you can cut them out - like so



Now you can make sticks to move your characters about on - draw a line from the top to the bottom of your paper when it is landscape ways and then fold card in half



Glue the card together and then glue it to the back of your character - making sure to glue in the middle of the body and not on the legs so you can move it about later



Now to design the background for your story - you can design multiple backgrounds for different scenes



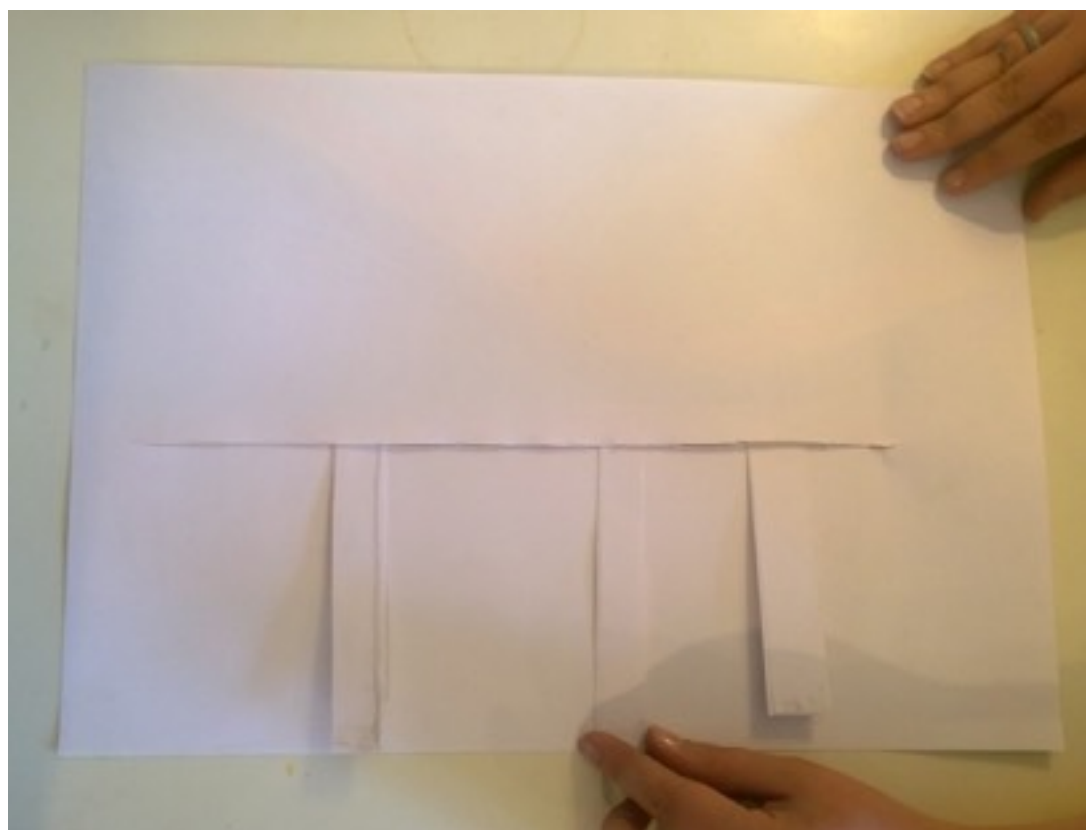
Measure your character against the background to ensure it looks like they are walking on the right bit - like so



Bend your paper to create a hole so you can then cut along to make a larger line - so your character can walk along the scene - which makes it a moving story



And there you have it your very own Moving Story
