

Pop Up Christmas Cards



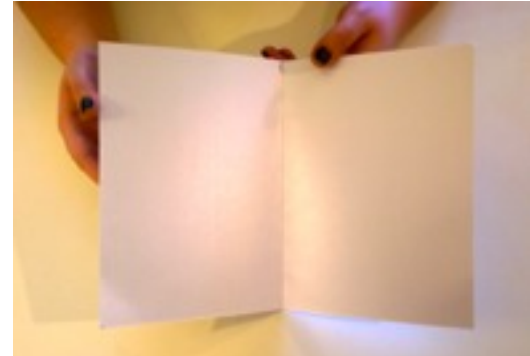
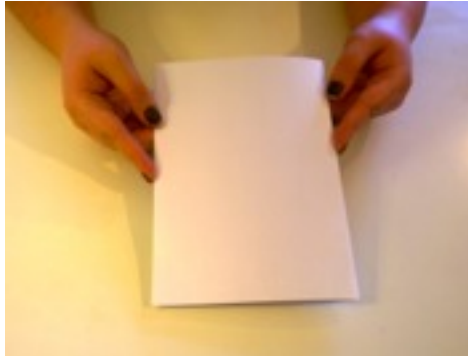
What better way to have some Christmas cheer than a pop up Christmas Card!

Tools and Materials:

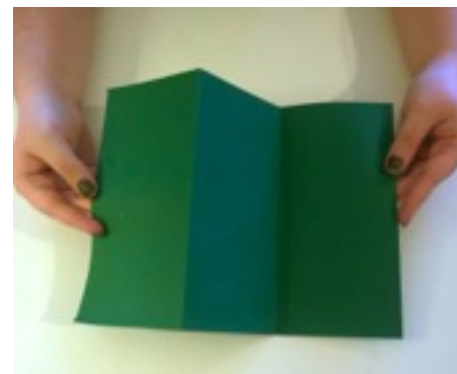
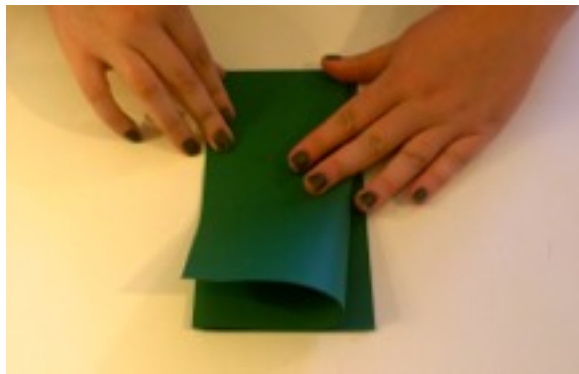
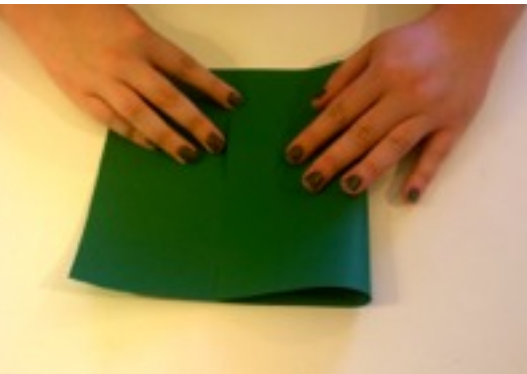
- Coloured Paper or Card
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Glue Stick
- Sellotape



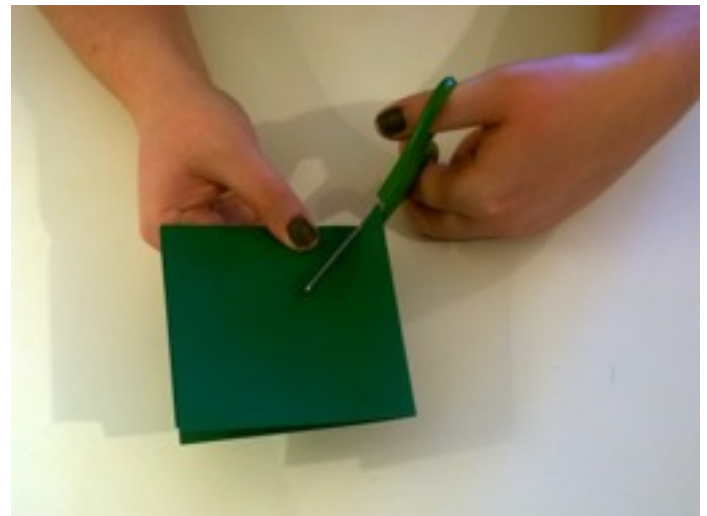
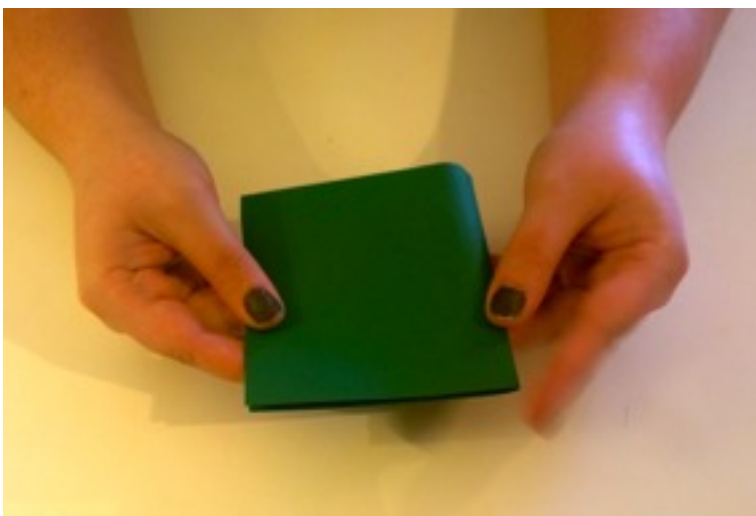
First choose which colour paper you could like to be the base of your card and fold it in half



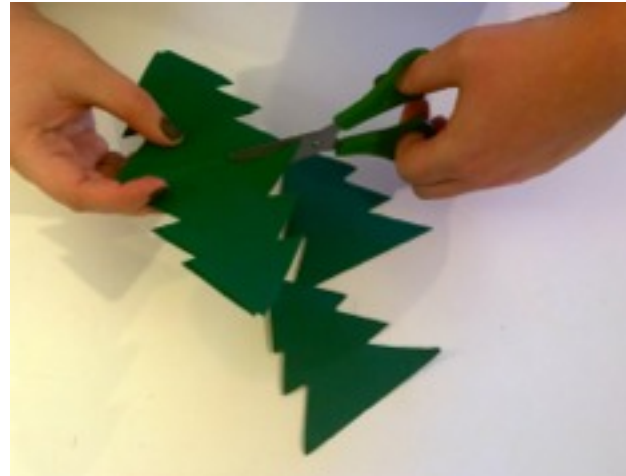
Now to make the tree - fold your green paper into 3 like so



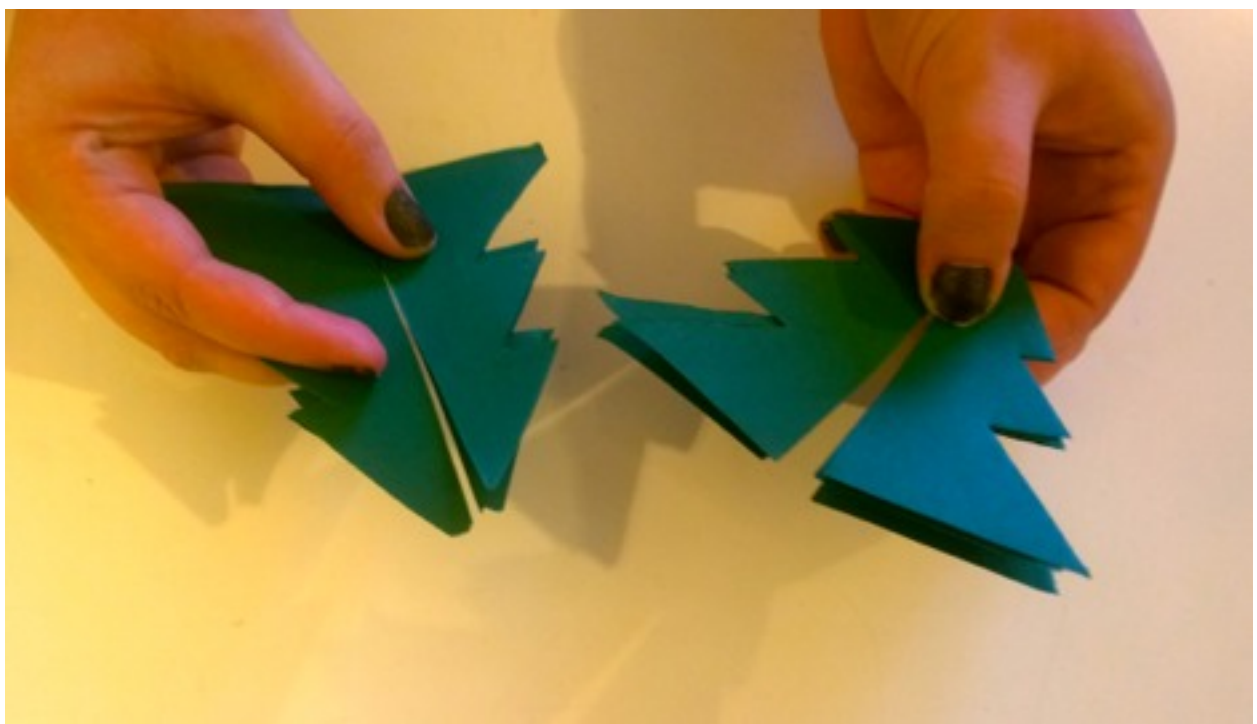
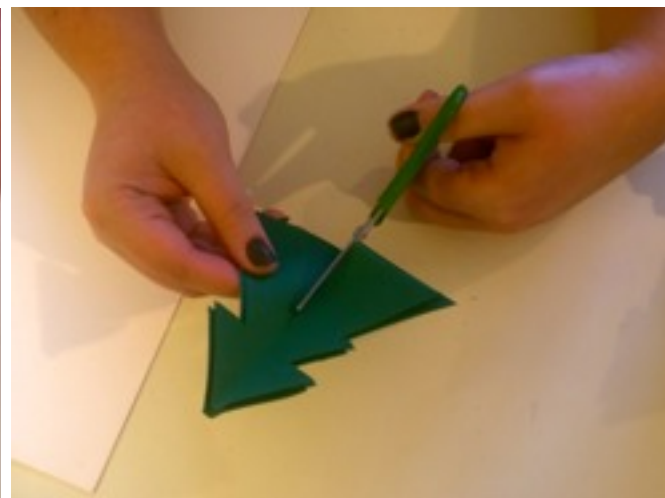
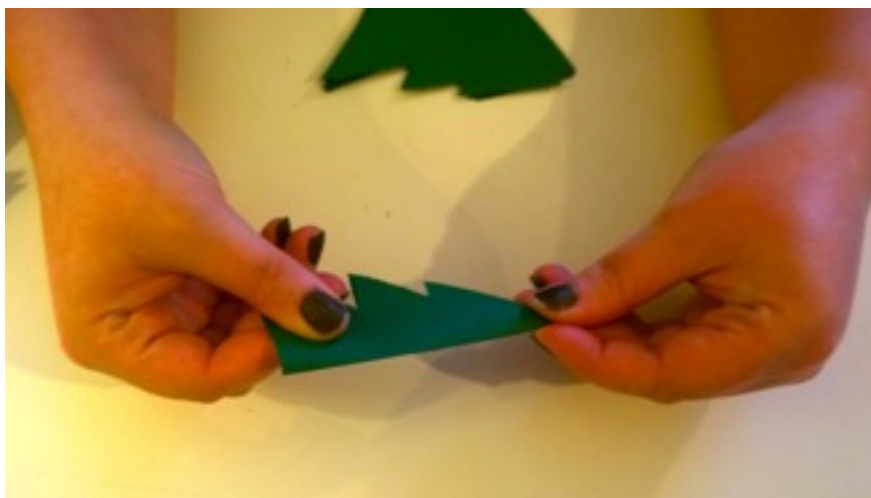
And then fold that in half so you can start cutting out trees



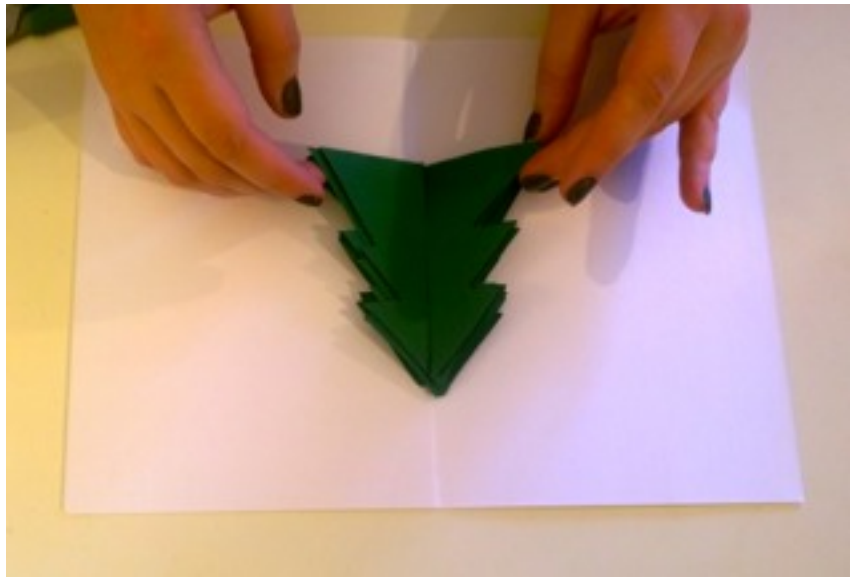
Now you can separate your trees



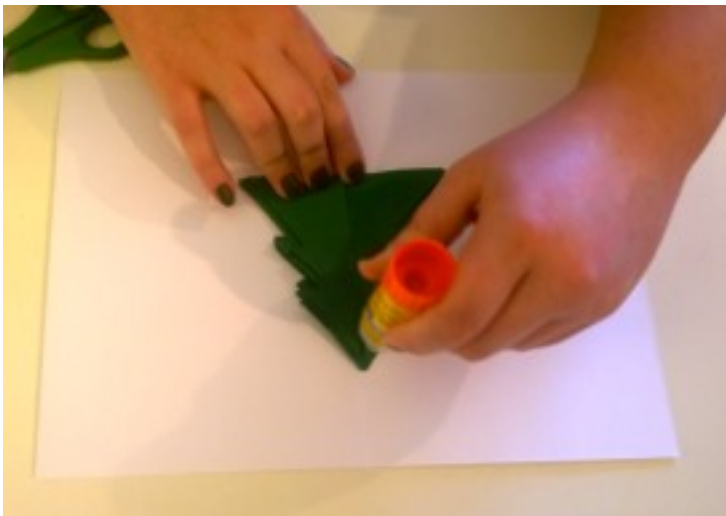
Fold all the trees in half and then take half of them and cut a slit from the bottom to the top about half the length of the tree, the other half do the same but bottom to top



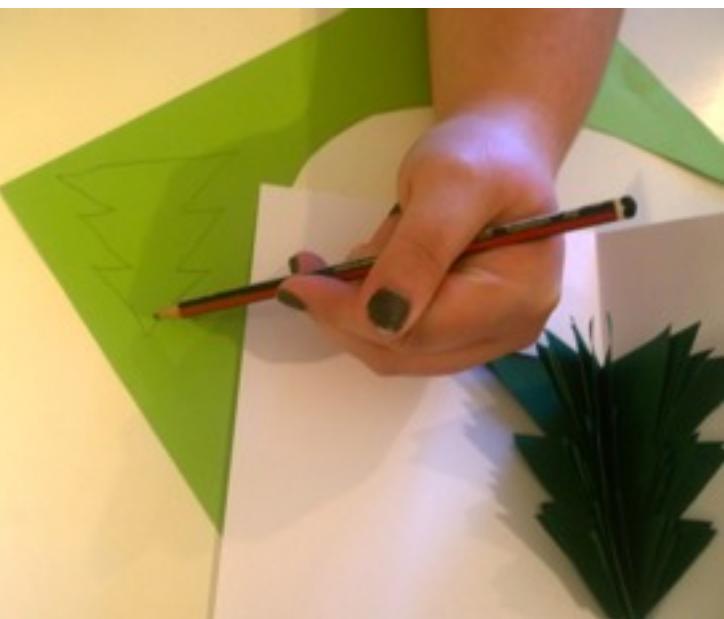
Slot the trees together and then glue the back to the card like so



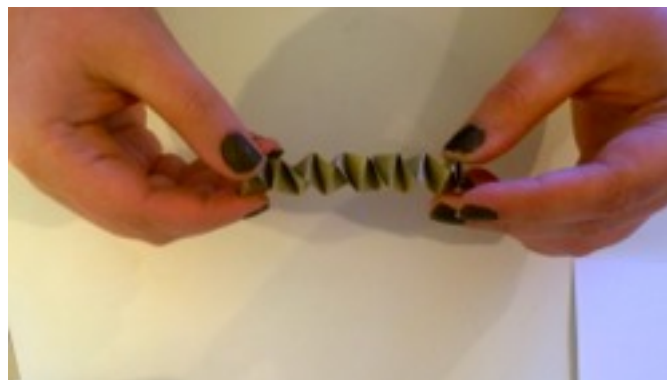
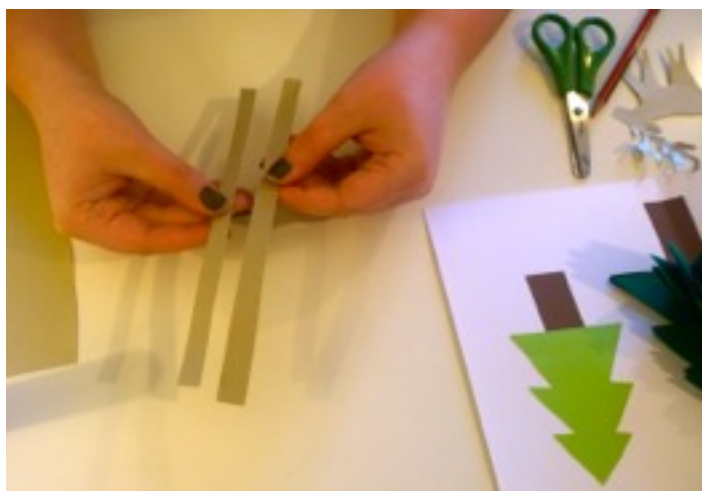
Glue the two middle sections of your tree to make it a bit stronger - it should end up looking like this



Now to create the rest of the decorations for your card, you can do a mix of flat images some to stick on the card and some to stick out of the card on springs!



To make a spring cut two bits of paper, secure them in an "L" shape with shape and then fold over each other like so



Attach the springs to the back of your cutouts and then to the card. There you have it your own
“Pop Up Christmas Card”
