Tissue Paper Watercolour



This is an inexpensive way to recreate paintings similar to using watercolour at home!

Tools and Materials:

- Coloured Tissue Paper
- Paintbrush
- Water
- Paper
- Scissors



Some tissue paper has been specially fixed so it won't lose its colour but most should work - first you need to decide what you want to create, you can use a mix of ripping for more abstract shapes and cutting out for the details like so



Once you are happy with the bits then you can start to lay them out where you want them to create your image



Once you are sure you can wet the tissue paper with the paintbrush - this is where the water comes in - put quite a lot of water on - the more you put the better the colour will come out!



Once you have covered all of your image and you are happy there is enough water leave it for 5 - 10 minutes so that the dye from the tissue paper can transfer on to your paper - be careful if you are doing this on a table it could stain so best to put newspaper or something else down to protect the surface just in case!



Start peeling off the tissue paper to reveal your design!



And there you have it your own tissue paper watercolour
