

## Easter Basket







You can create an egg-cellent Easter basket to store all your chocolate in! You could even use it on an Easter Egg hunt if you wanted to organise one!

### Tools and Materials:

- Coloured Paper
- Pencil
- Sellotape
- Double-sided Tape
- Scissors
- Lolly Sticks (there are 5 sides on an open cube so minimum you would need is 20 but we used 62!)





To make the basket you need to make a cube missing one side - so 5 sides in total, making a frame of 4 sticks to make a square like so using the double sided sticky tape





So the basket has 4 sides and a bottom - for the side panels you can use paper or cover in sticks to make it stronger - we decided to make the bottom and 2 of the sides with sticks just to mix it up a bit

Take you frames and cover them with lolly sticks - you might need to move the end ones if they don't fit and then add 2 lolly sticks across to secure it



Now you can fill the other 2 sides with paper - measuring round them like so



Time to decorate them! What do you think would look good on your Easter basket? Could it be eggs, or chicks or even a lamb like we chose to do!




After attaching your paper to the frames now you can put the basket sides together. Lay the 4 sides frames together and tape them from the inside like so



Once the sides have been put together you need to add the bottom - this is a bit trickier because if you want to tape it from the inside which looks neater; start with two strips to make like a lid then flip it the other way to add the tape from the inside.



Now to create your handle - cut a long strip of paper and tape it to the inside to secure it.



There you have it your very own Easter Basket!
