

Perspective



This is a basic way of learning about perspective with a vanishing point on the horizon - to give an impression of depth

Tools and Materials:

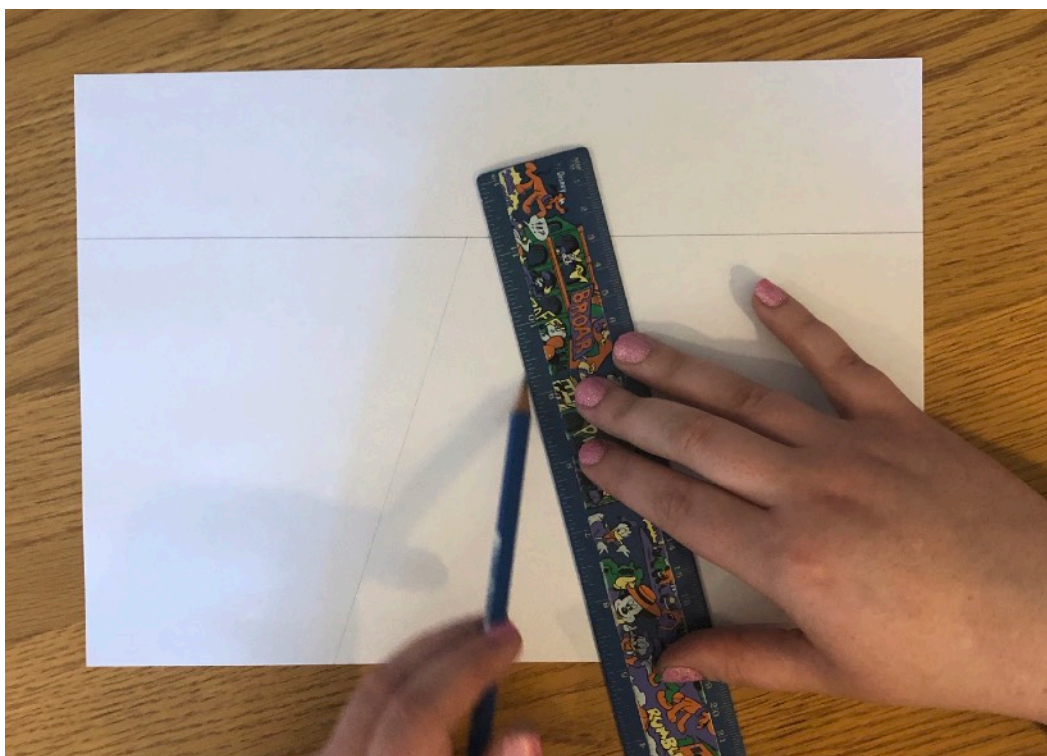
- Paper
- Pencil
- Ruler



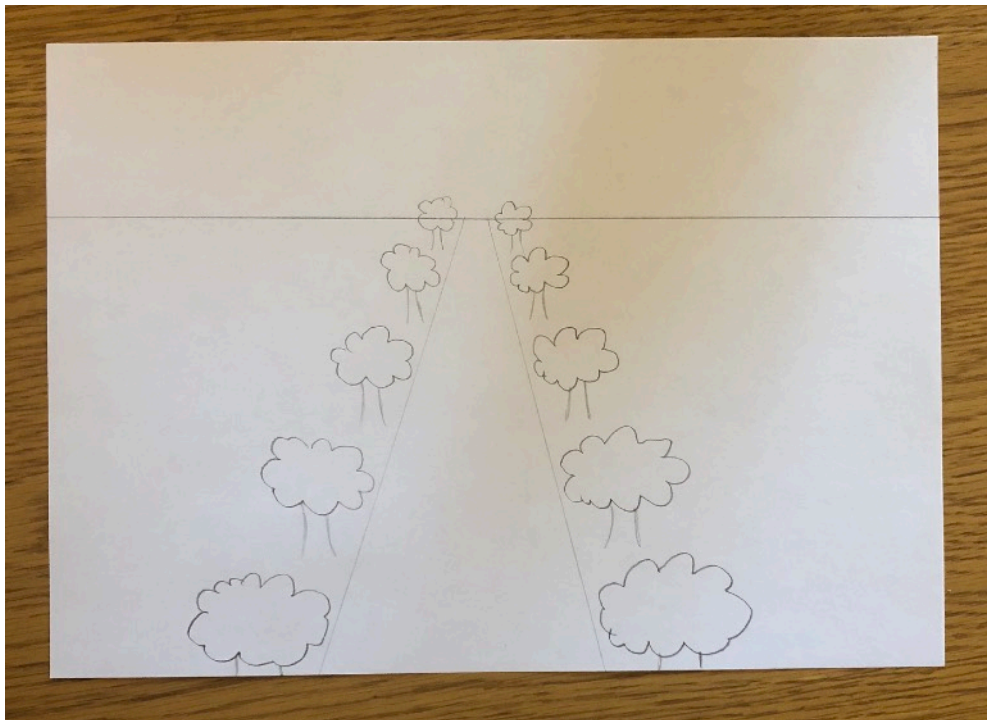
First of all you need to put in the horizon about 3/4 of the way up the page



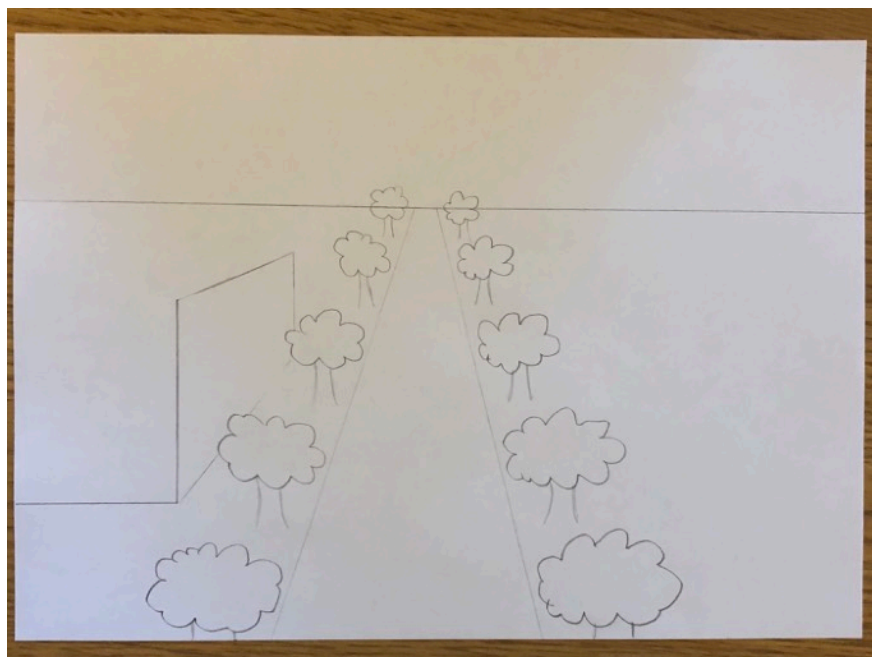
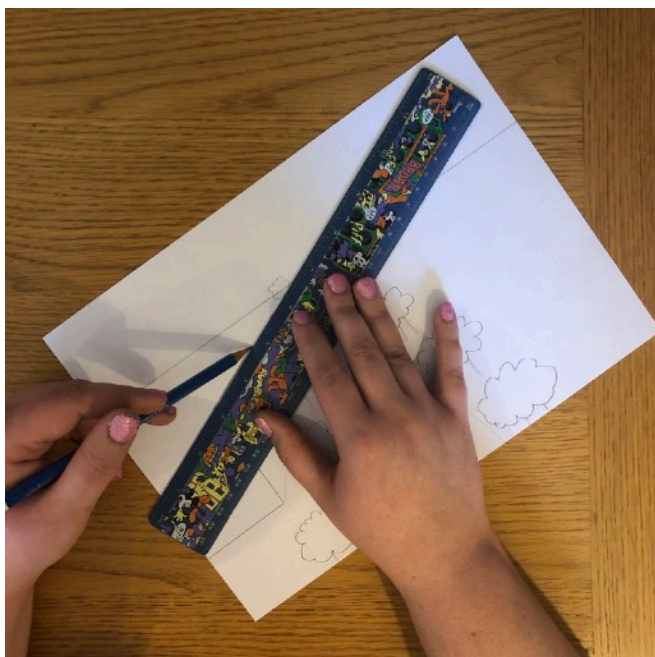
Then think about what it is you want to draw - a path through houses is a nice way to try and figure out basic perspective. When you draw your lines the path is smaller at the top extending at the bottom



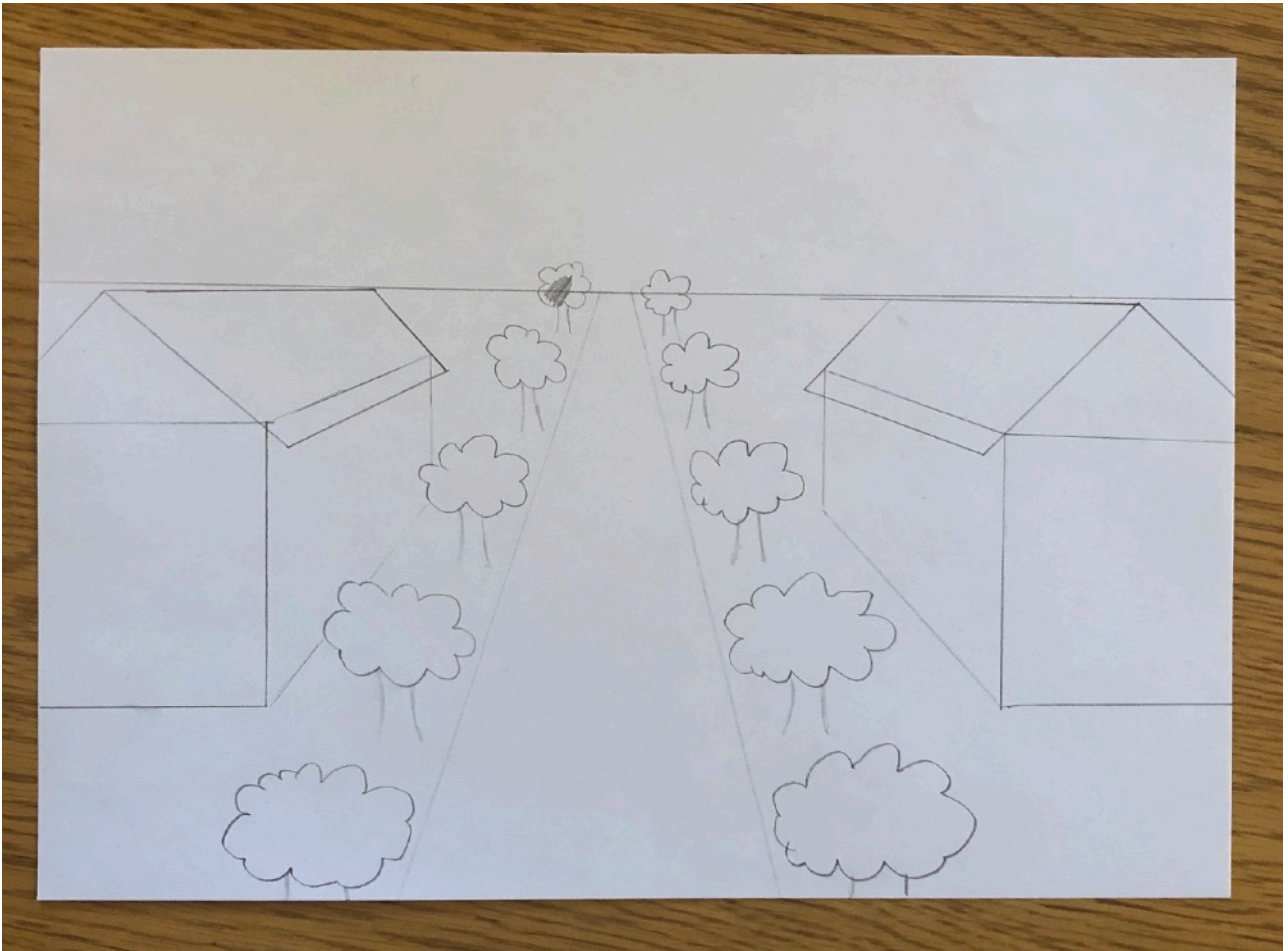
Then what else could be in your picture - we thought a tree lined street would be fun! The closer things get to the horizon the smaller they get like so



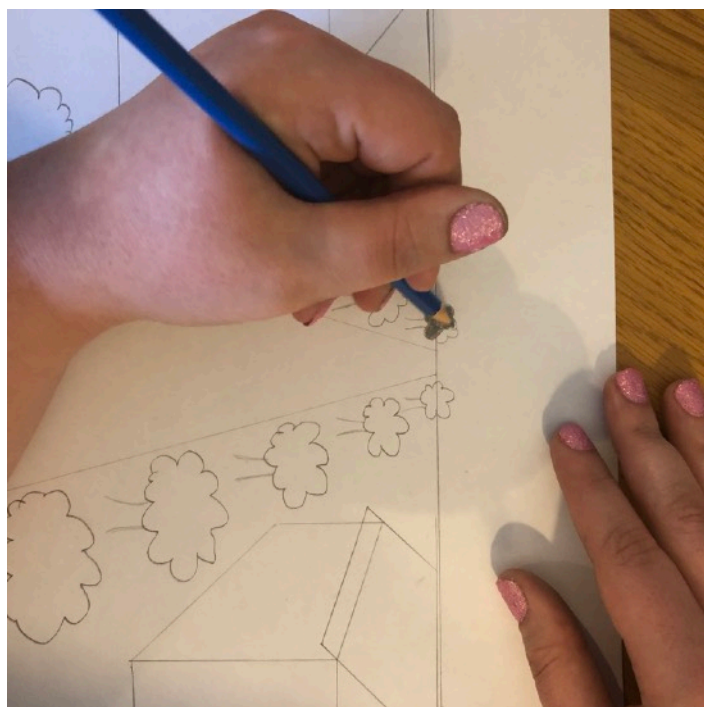
Now to add in houses - the points you have done for you path at the horizon you need to use as a guide for your angles like so



You should end up with something like this - making sure you always use the top of the path road each side as a reference point



Once you are happy with your drawing you can start adding more detail
