

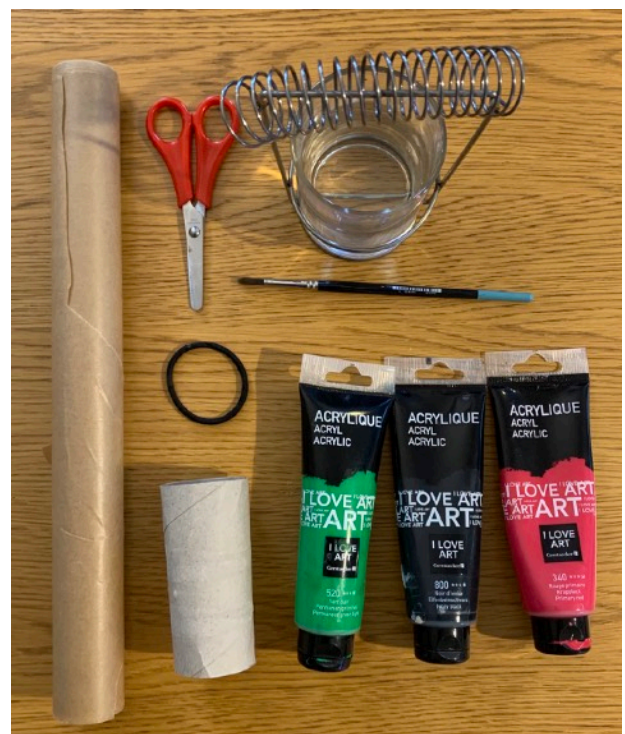
## Upcycled Kazoo



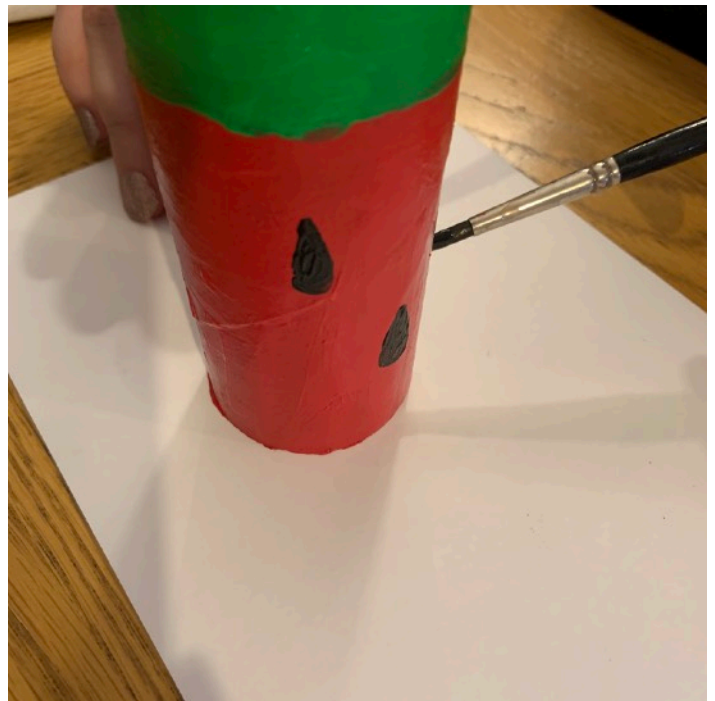
You can create your own upcycled kazoo from everyday household objects - kazoos are usually metal or plastic instruments you hum into to make a noise, simple but effective!

### Tools and Materials:

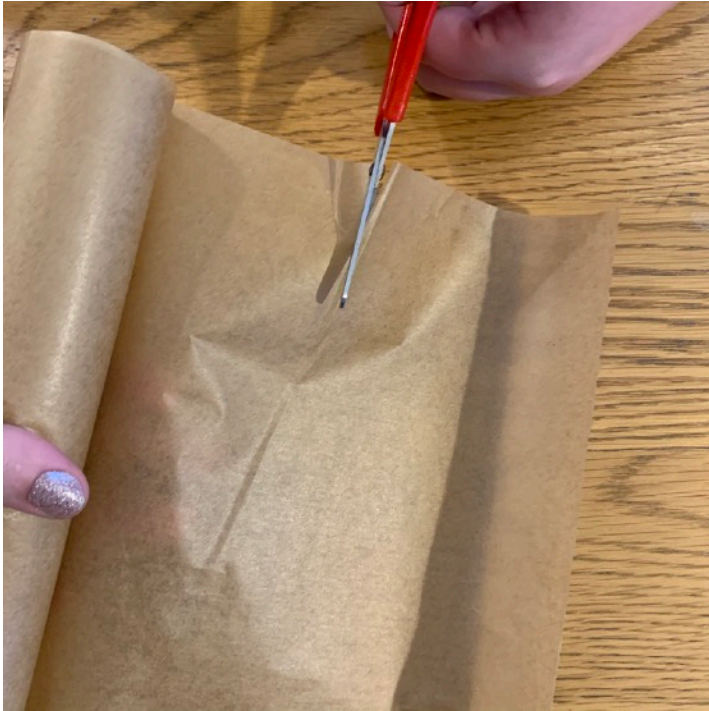
- Kitchen or Toilet Paper inner cardboard tube
- Paintbrush
- Paint
- Water
- Scissors
- Rubber Band (or Hair Band)
- Greaseproof Paper



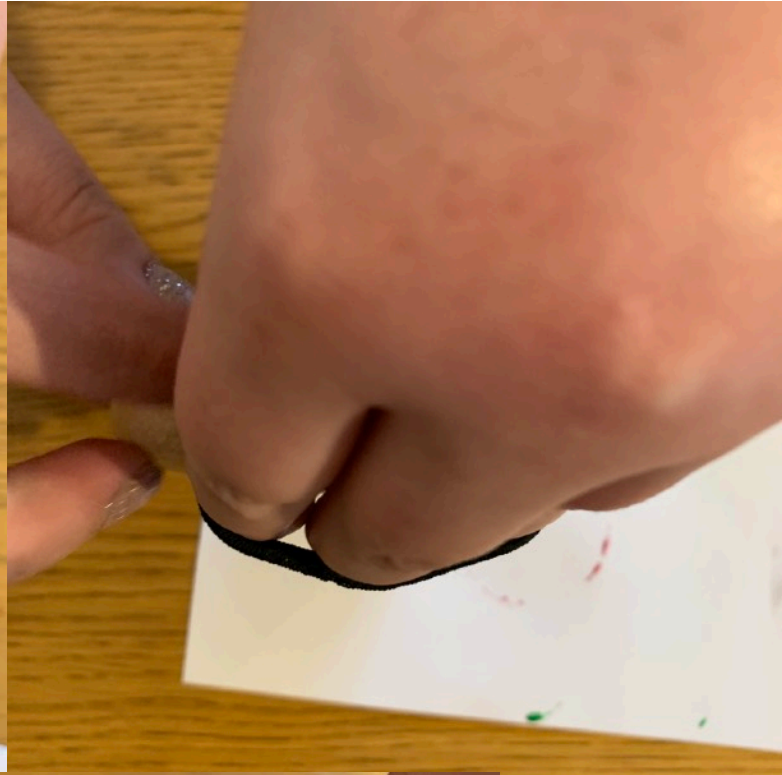
To make the kazoo you just need the cardboard tube, greaseproof paper and rubber band - but we wanted it to look more exciting! So you can transform the tube with paint into something else completely! What do you think would look good? We thought a watermelon would be super fun! We used some paper to put our paint on, add the red and green paint first - wait for it to dry and then add the black for the seeds on top. It's a good idea to put paper on the table too to protect it from paint!



Once your tube is dry you need to cut a square of greaseproof paper to put over the top - this needs to be bigger than the top of the tube because you also want to then trim the square into a circle to look a bit neater



Place the circle over the end of the cardboard tube and attach with the rubber band - you want it to be tight to be secure but not so tight it makes the cardboard collapse in. You can decide which end you think will look better to be covered, it is completely up to you!



There you have it your very own “Upcycled Kazoo” - if you place the uncovered end to your mouth and hum through the tube it should make noise like vibrating hum/buzz - enjoy!
