

Paper Sculpture Portrait



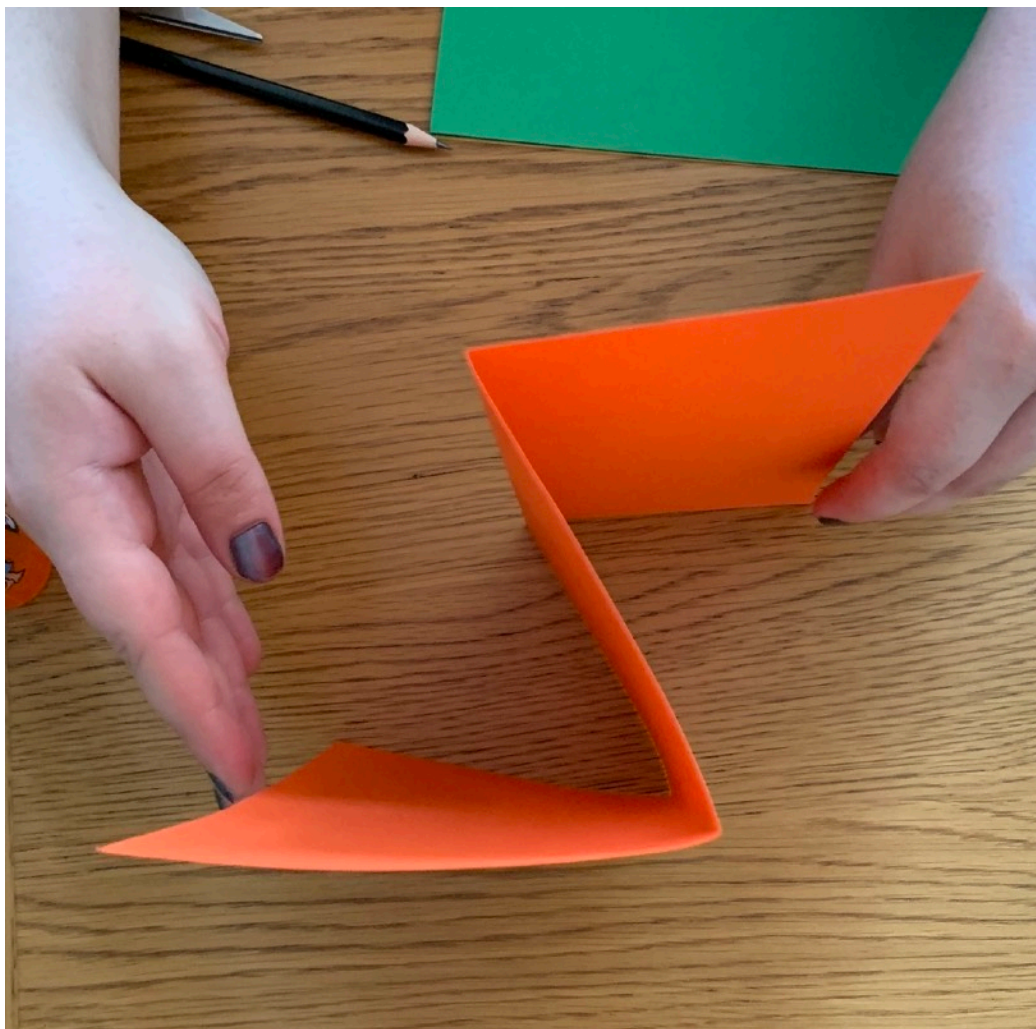
Taking inspiration from Picasso's Paper Portraits why not create you own portrait which can stand up like so!

Tools and Materials:

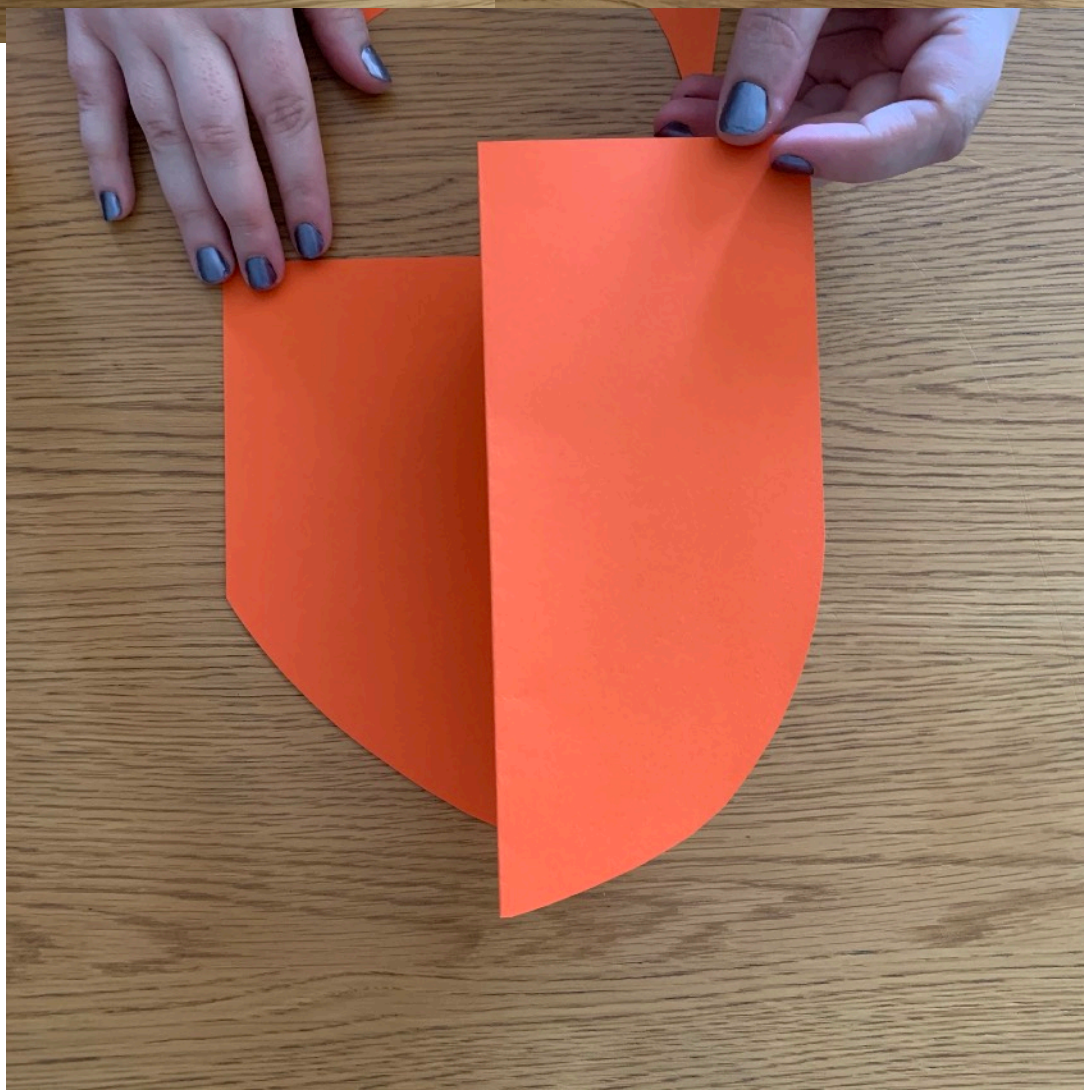
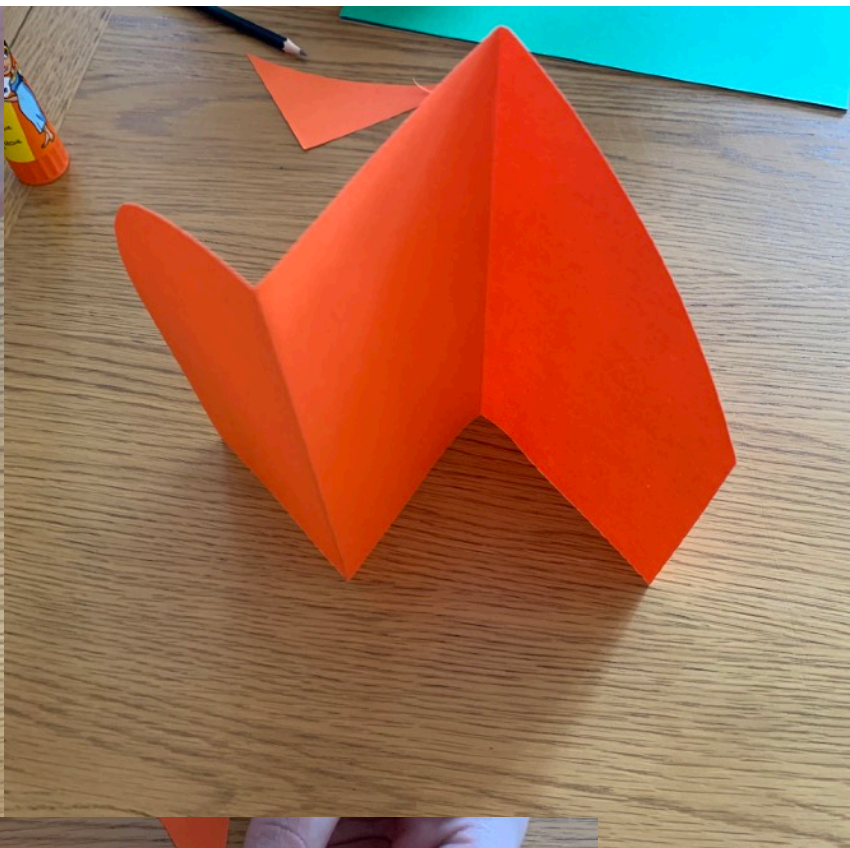
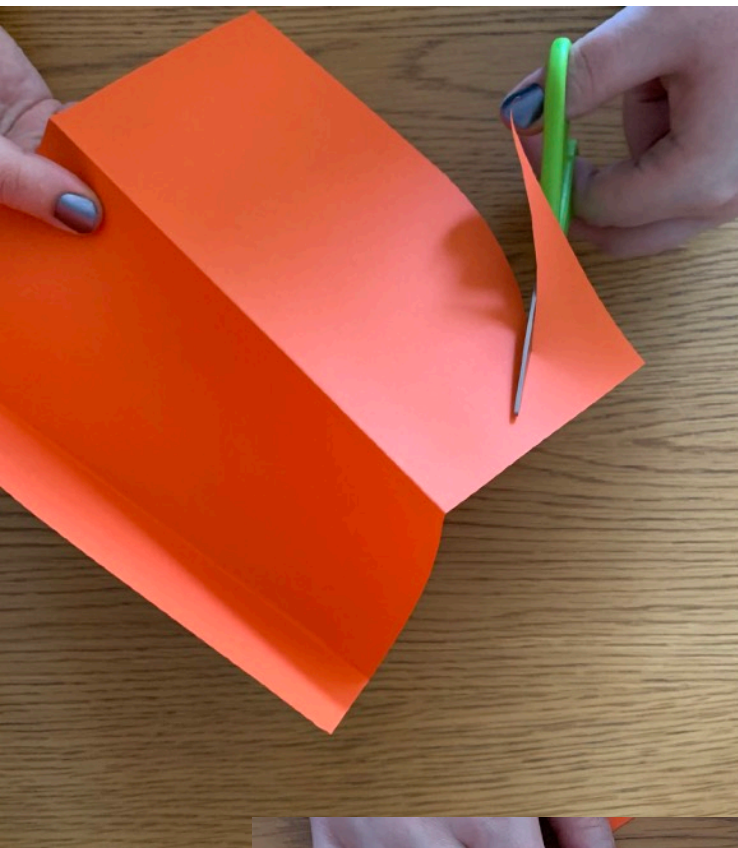
- Coloured Paper
- Pencil
- Gluestick
- Scissors



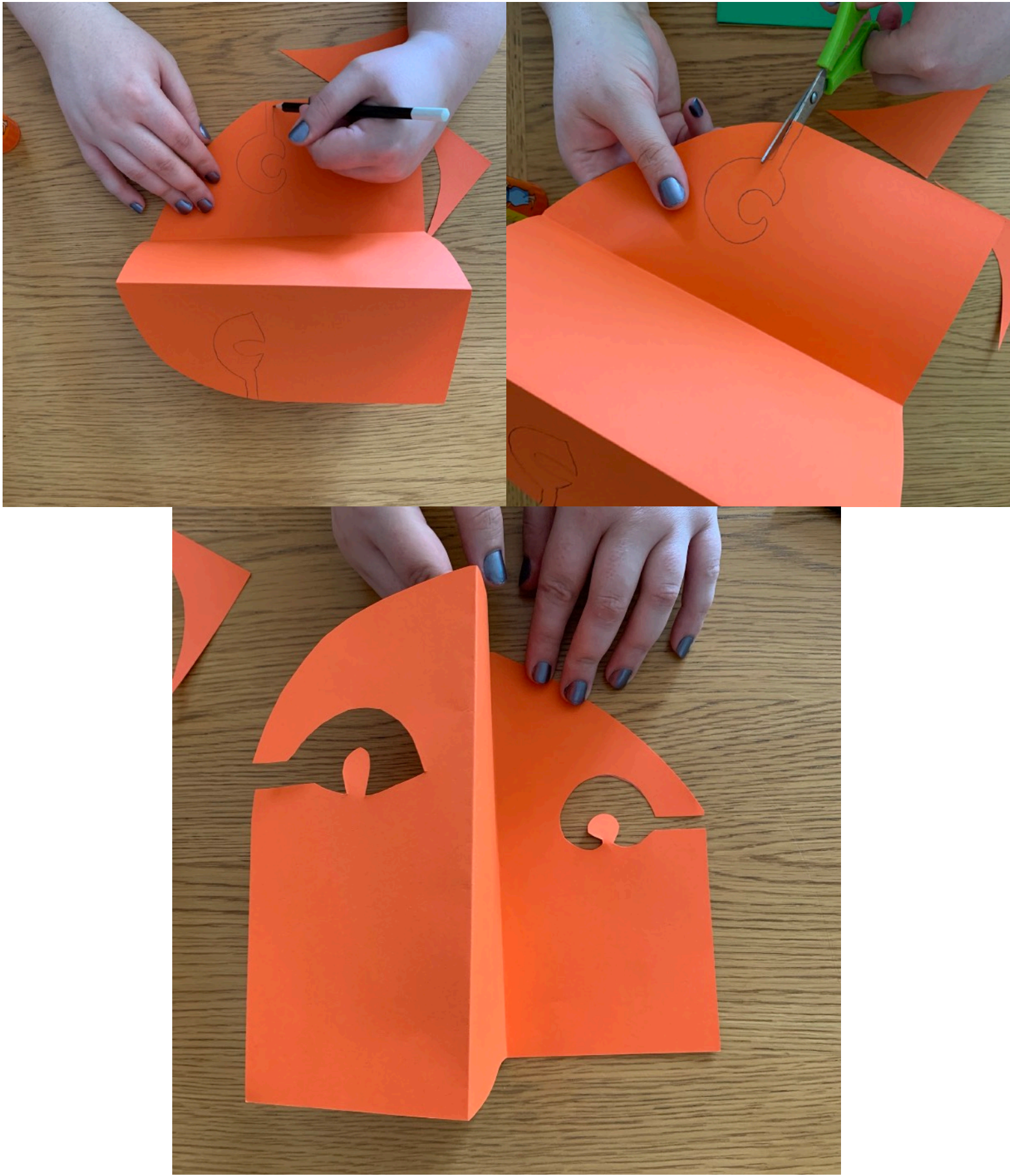
First of all choose what colour you would like to make the face - it doesn't have to be realistic - you could have a purple face if you want! Fold the paper into 3 a bit like a menu or a Z so it can stand like so



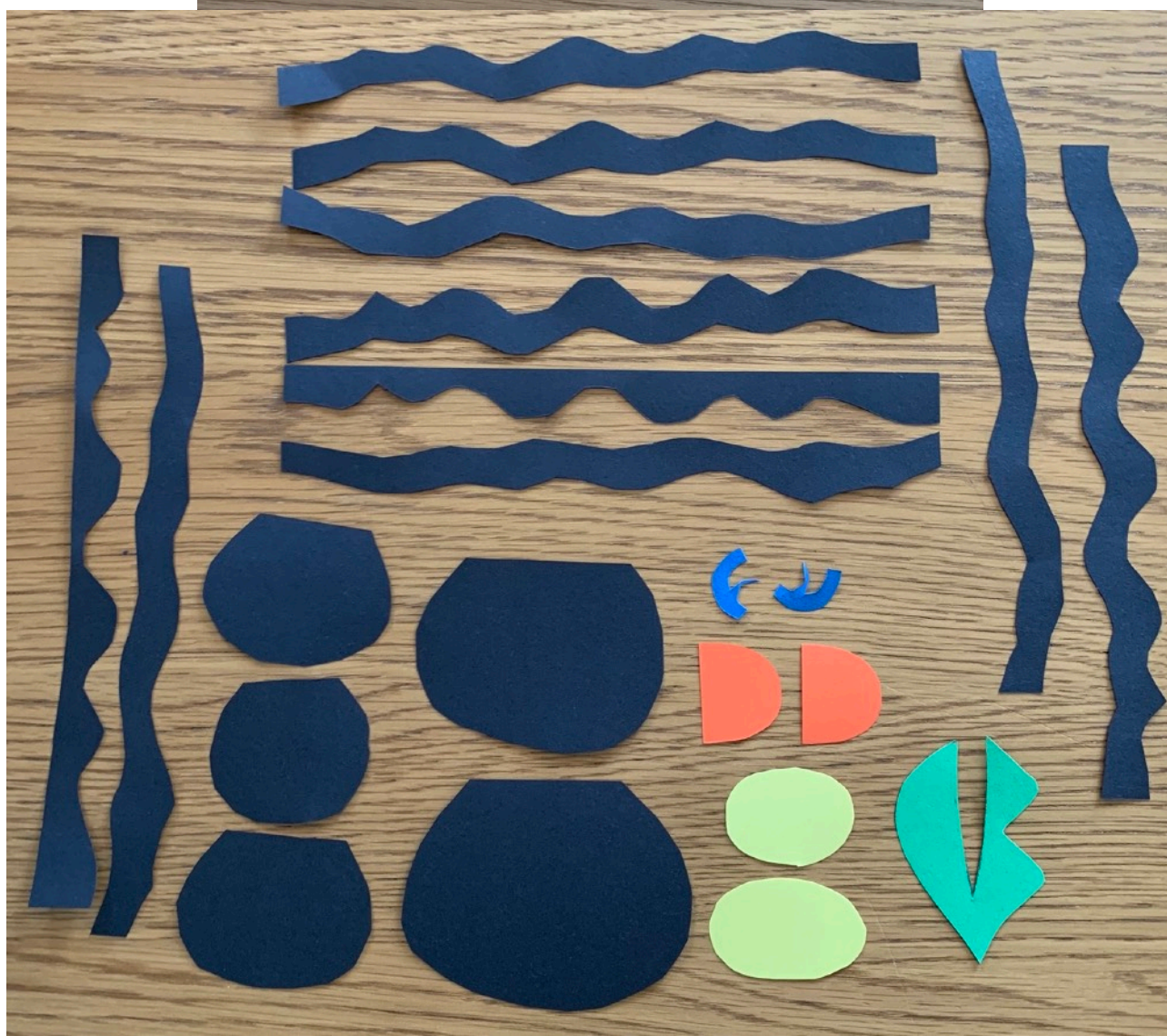
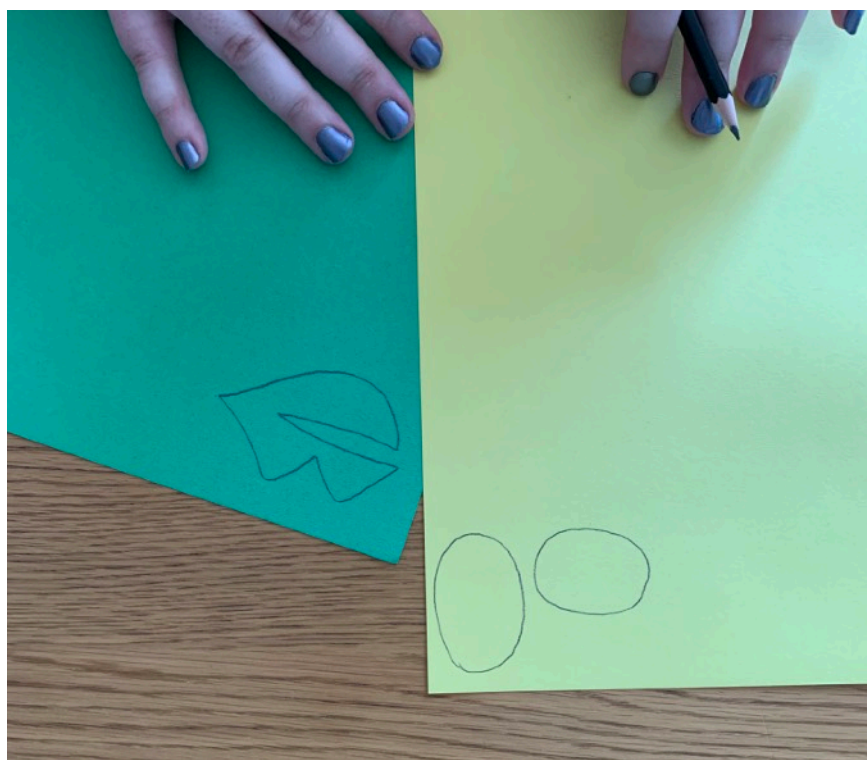
Once you have the base for the face you can think about shaping the edges to be curved more like an actual face



Now you can think about the facial features - because this is a standing piece and you can see through it you can mix between cut outs and collage to create the features. We used cut outs to form the eyes on ours.



So onto the other features you might want to think about lips, ears, rosy cheeks, freckles, hair and even eyebrows - whatever you might want to feature on the portrait!



Once you have cut out all the pieces you need you can start to glue them on to the face like so



Once you are happy with all the elements you can shape the bottom of the face to be curved - just don't cut too much off so the face still balances



There you have it your very own “Paper Sculpture Portrait”!
