

Summer Solstice Headband



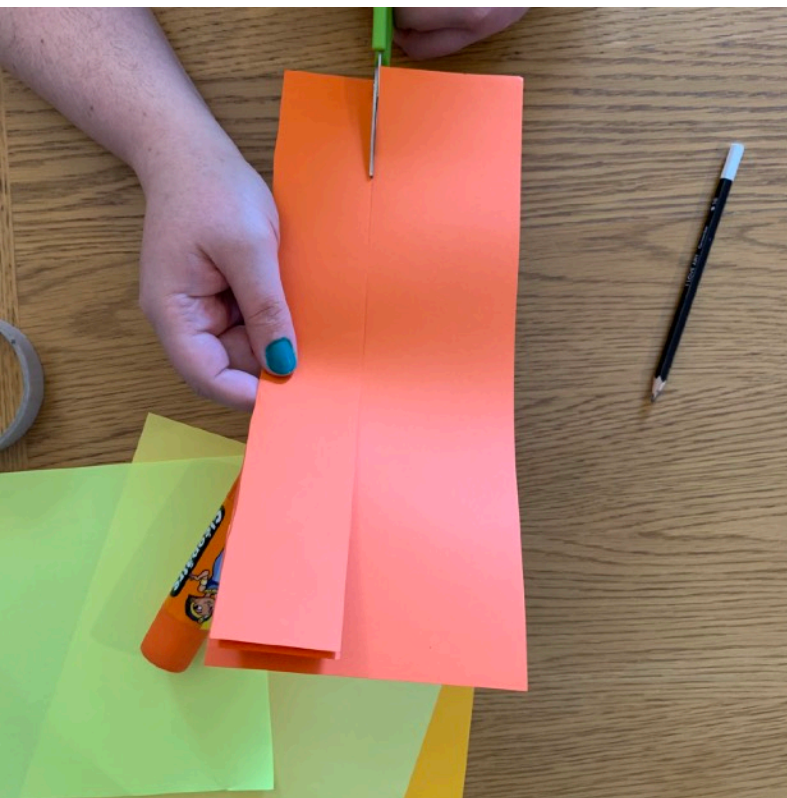
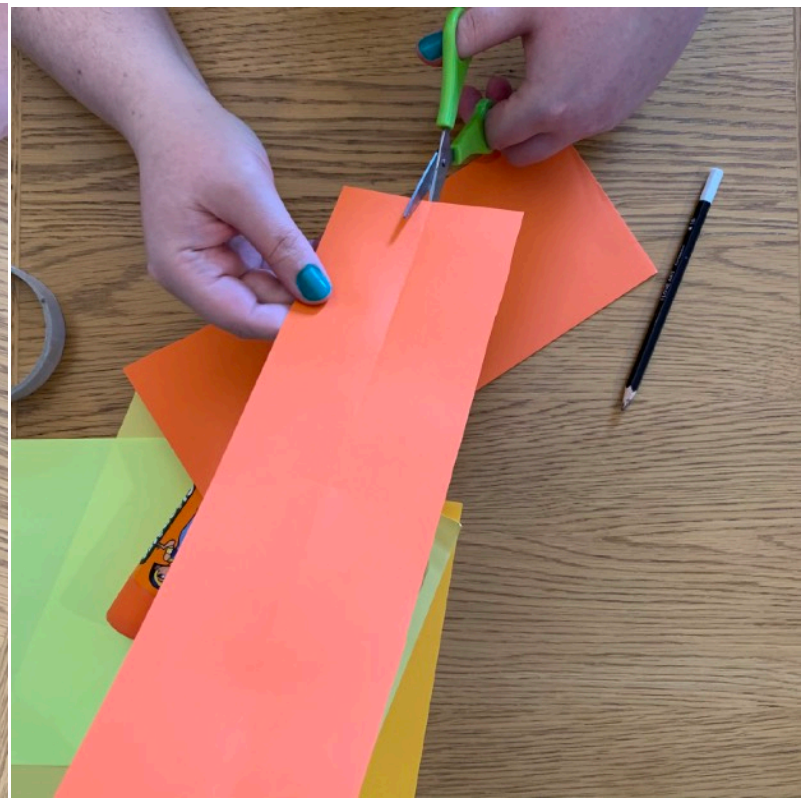
You could create this for the Summer Solstice or even just a Summer Festival - even in your own home, why not have fun dressing up!

Tools and Materials:

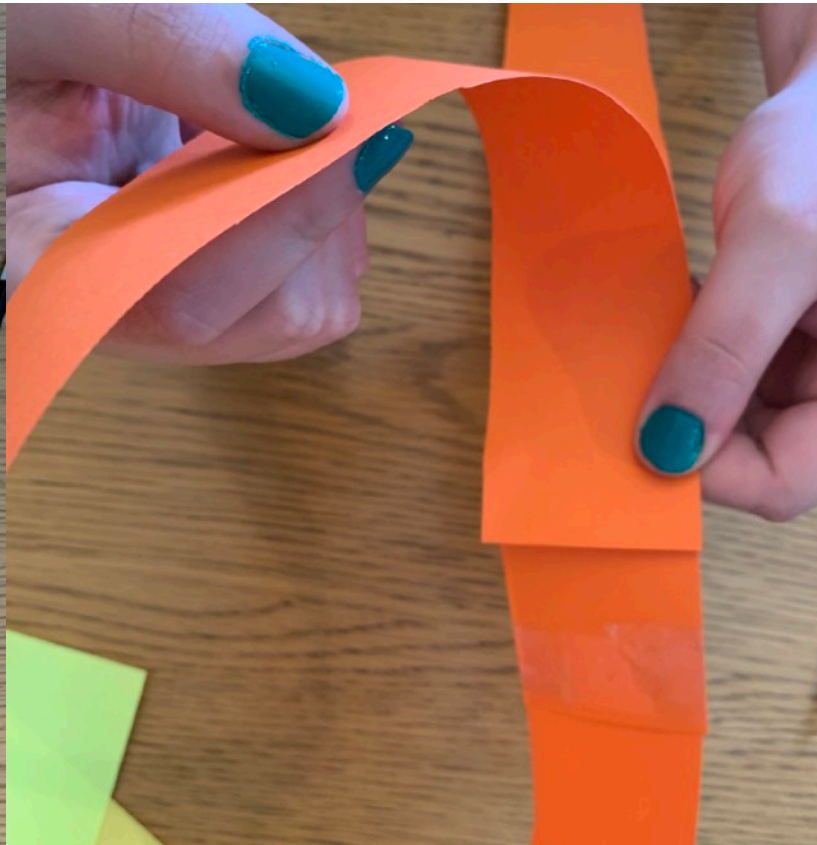
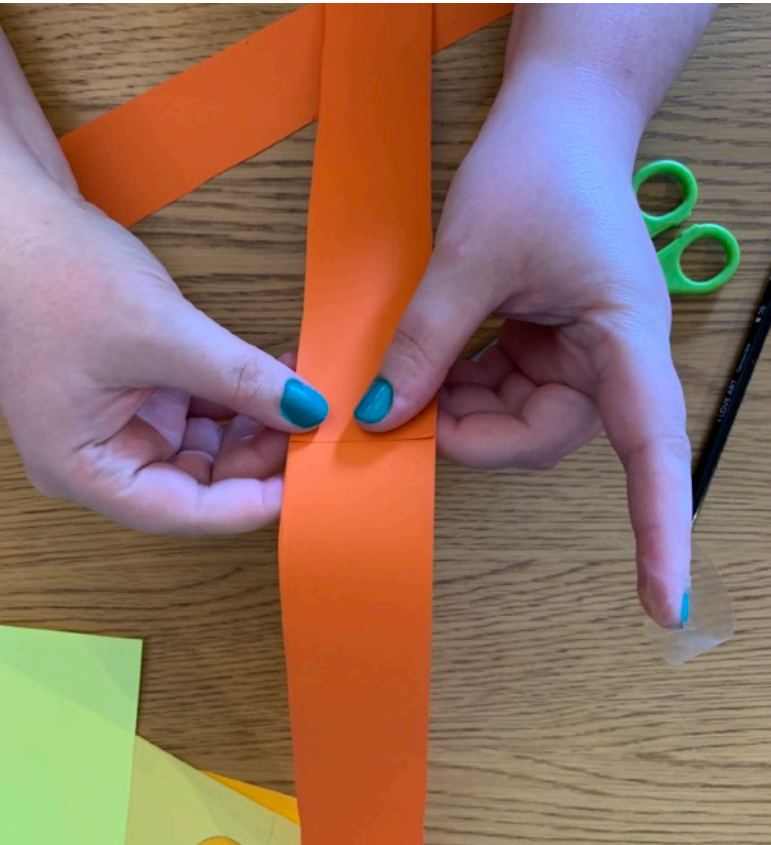
- Coloured Paper
- Pencil
- Gluestick
- Scissors
- Sellotape



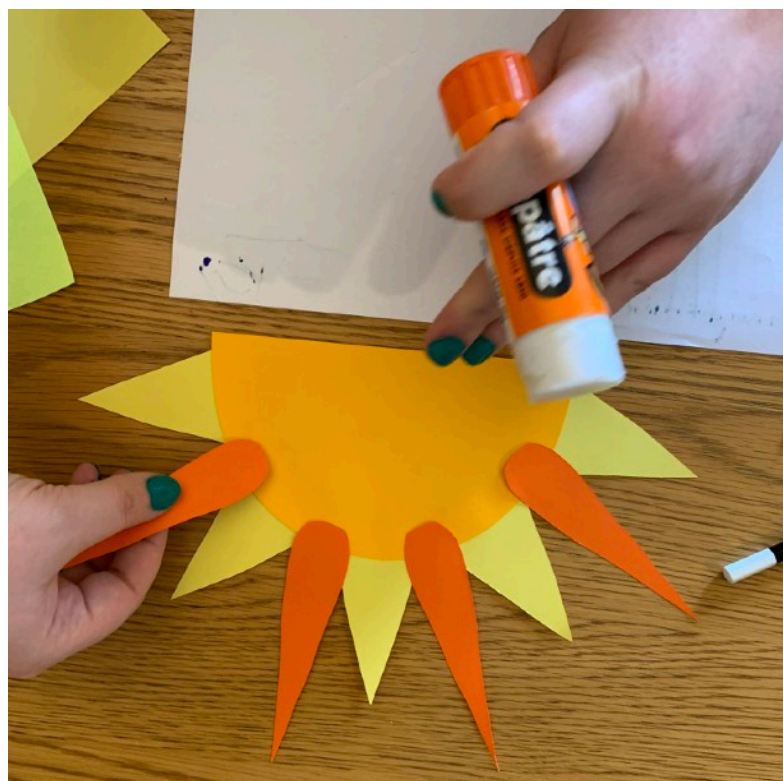
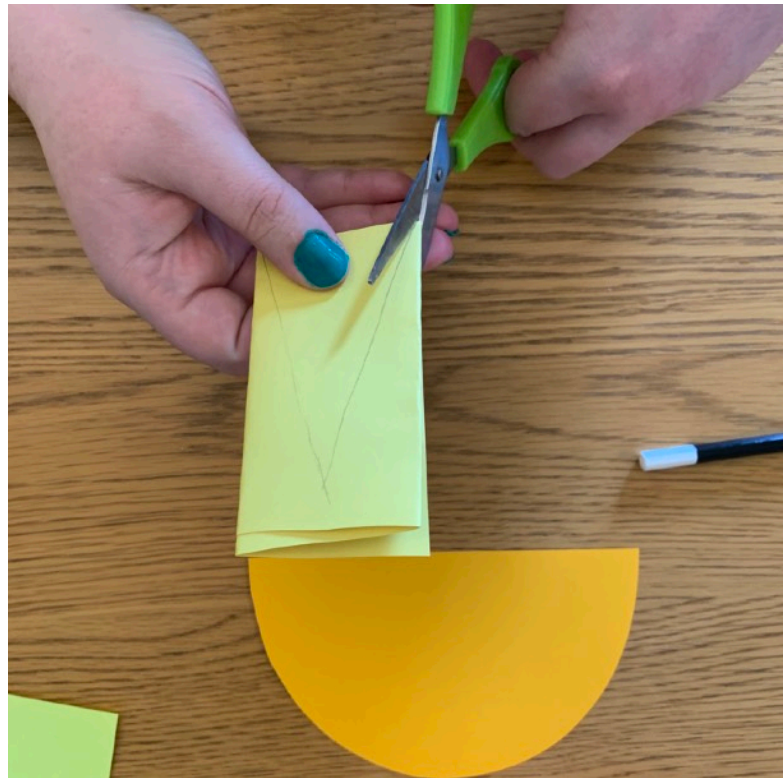
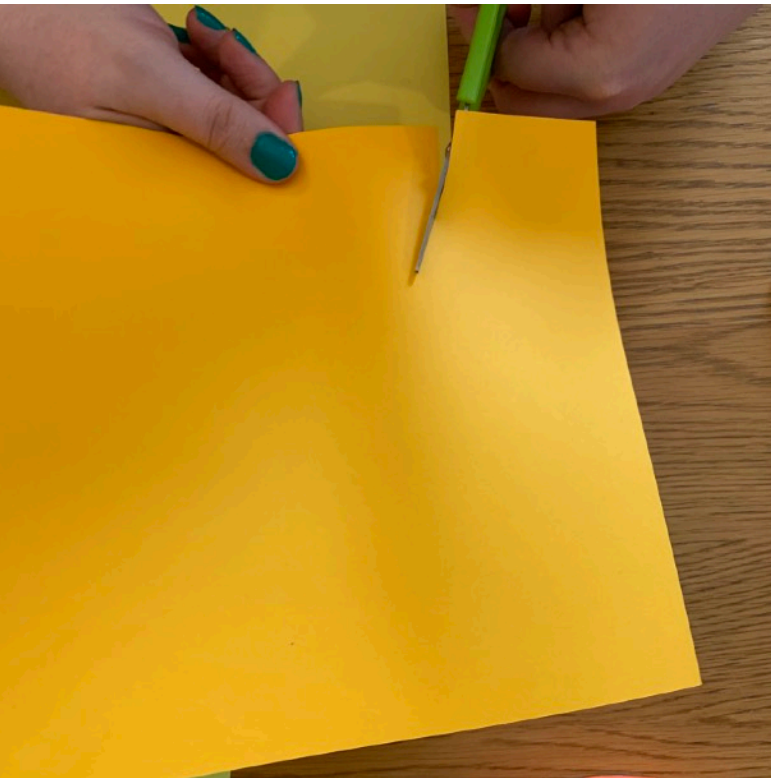
First of all you need to create a band to fit on your head to transform with all your sun inspired decoration. Using an A4 bit of paper you will need to cut multiple strips to join together to fit around your head like so



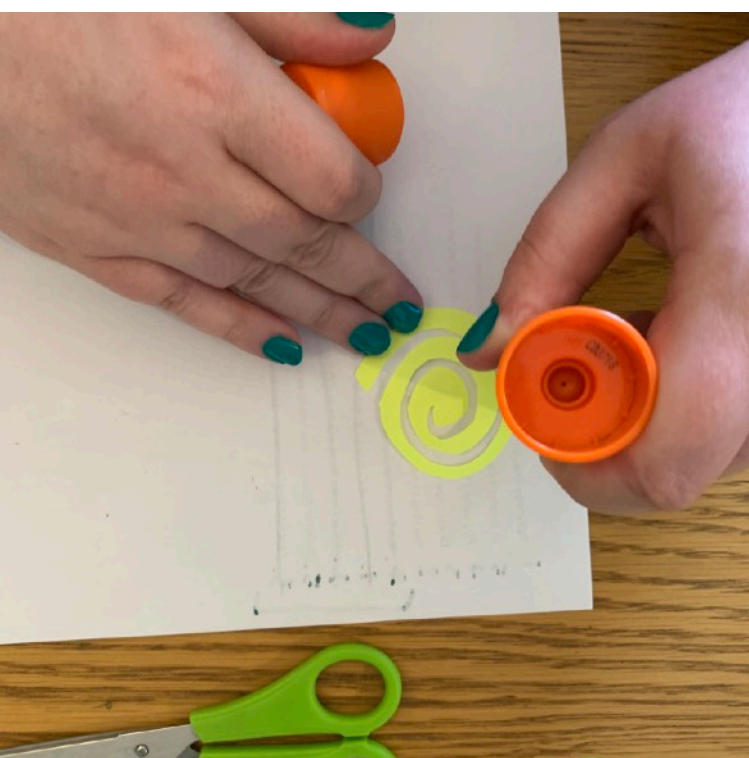
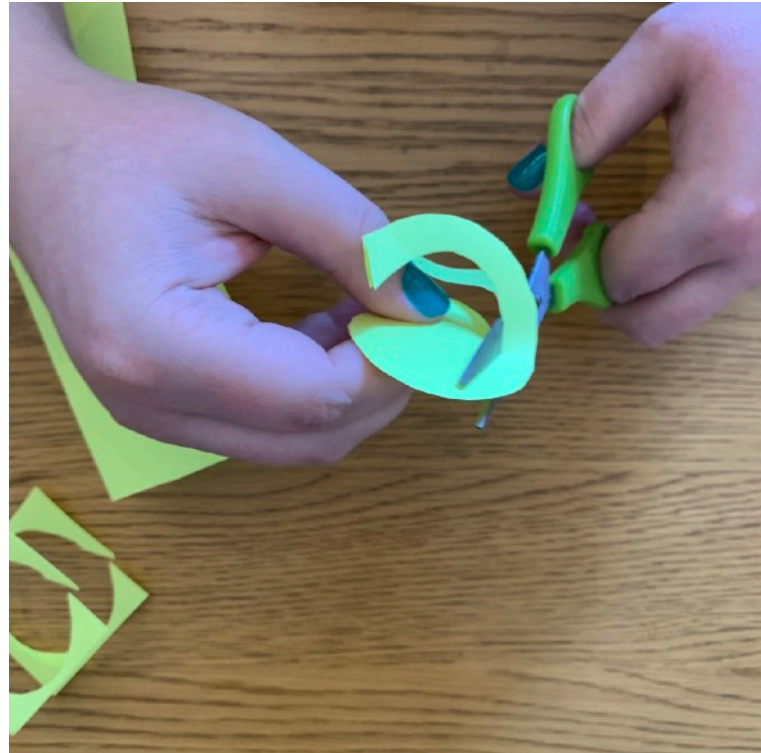
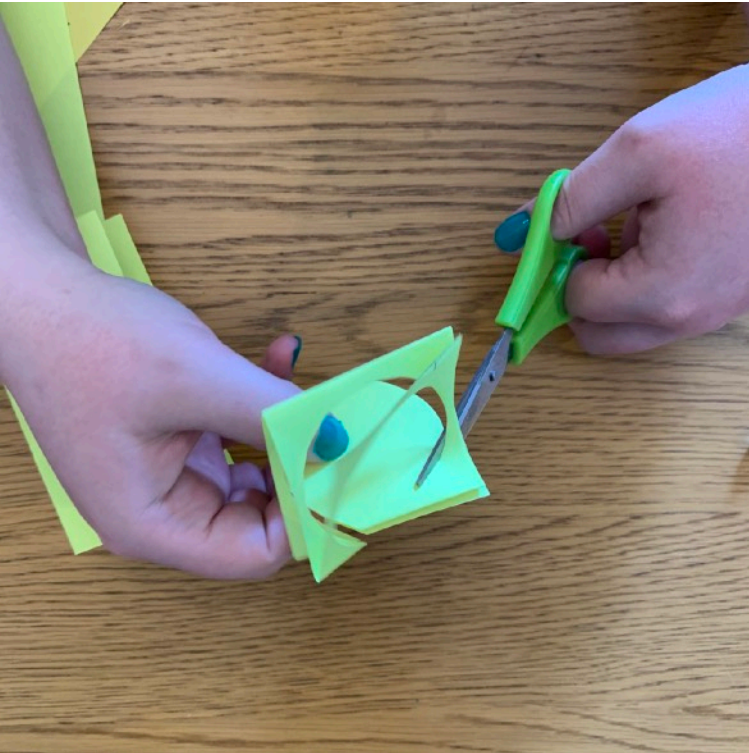
Sellotape two ends together to make a long strip - you might need to use all three strips depending on head size. Measure it around your head to make a circle and then tape it to itself and cut off the excess



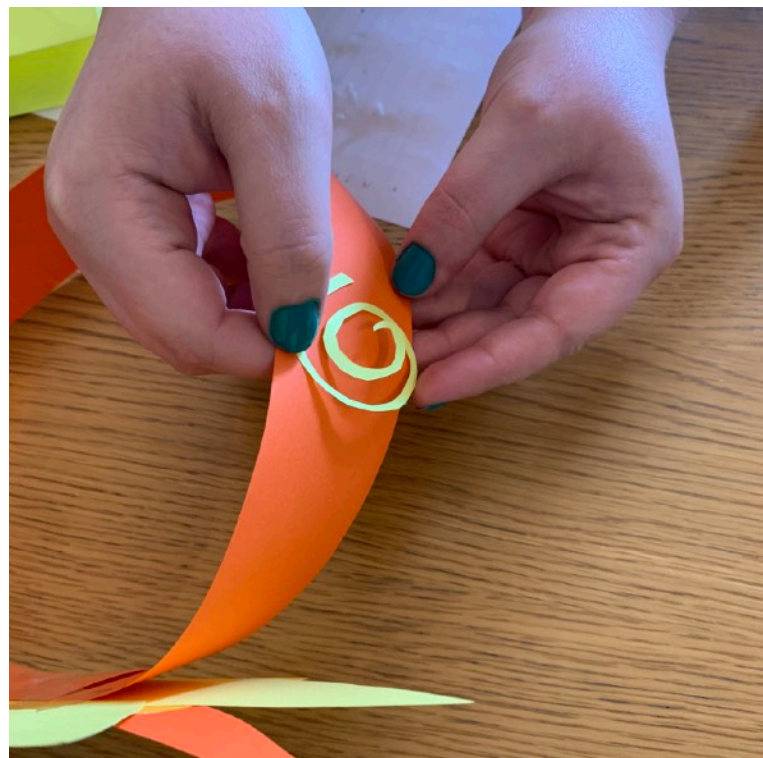
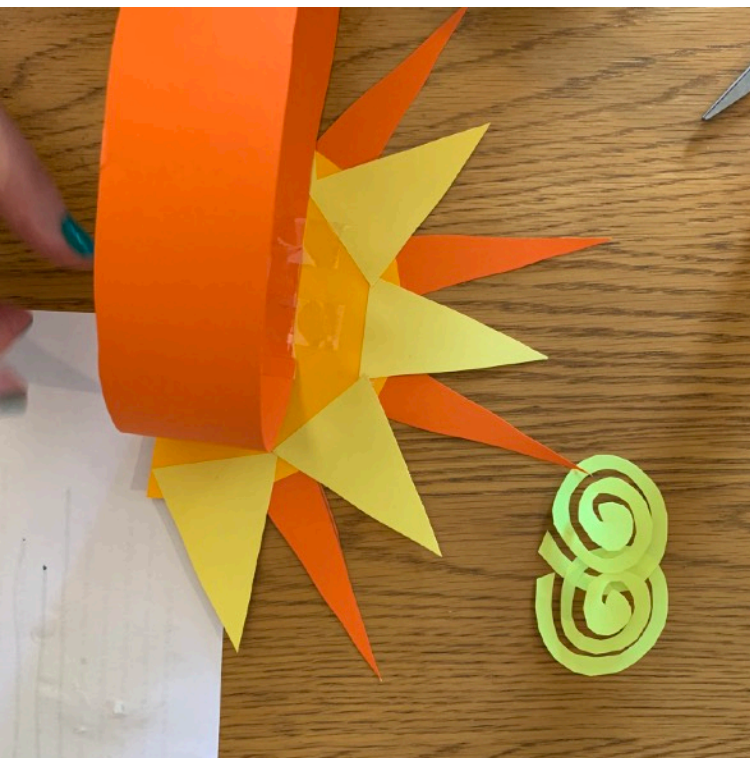
Now to decorate! We drew and cut out a semi circle as the base of our sun, and using other sun-like colours cut out rays for the sun and then glues them on



To add some extra depth we created some spirals start with a small circle and then cut inside it to create a spiral. When sticking it on don't glue the whole spiral, put glue mainly on the larger sections (outer rings) of circle so the middle is still able to move about



When you have finished decorating your sun you can attach it to the head band. We folded sellotape back on itself to attach the sun to the band as well as putting extra tape on the remainder sticking up from the band like so, you can add the rest of the spirals around the band too!



There you have it your very own
“Summer Solstice Headband”!
