

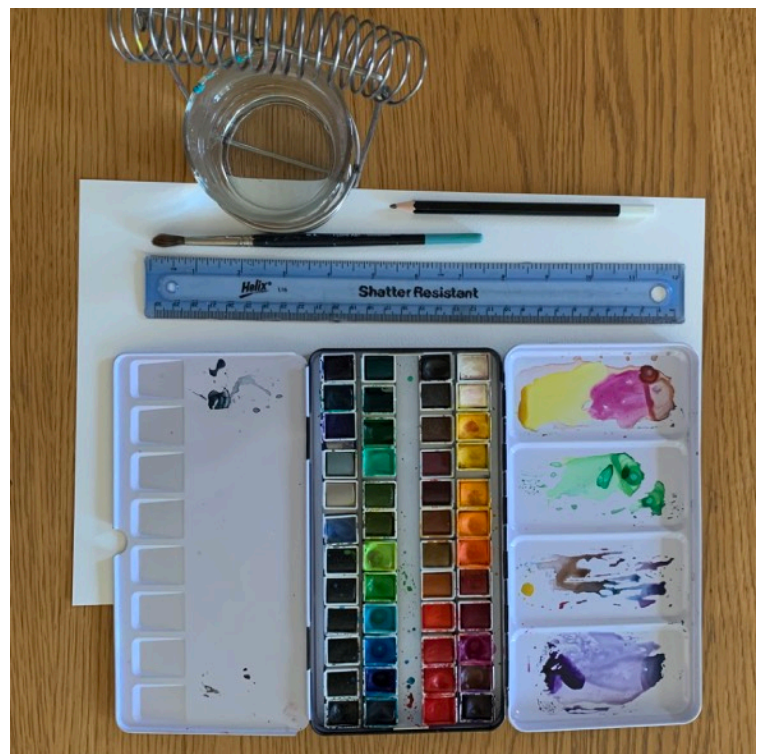
Art Focus: Hilma af Klint



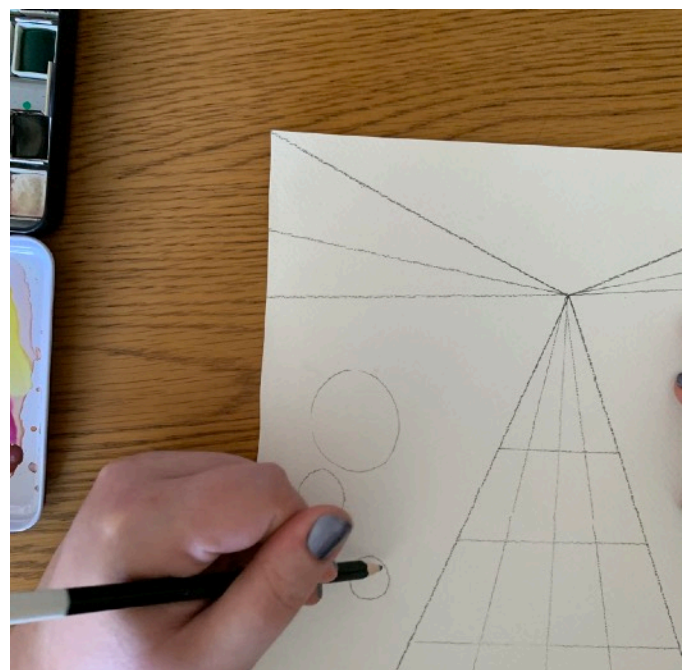
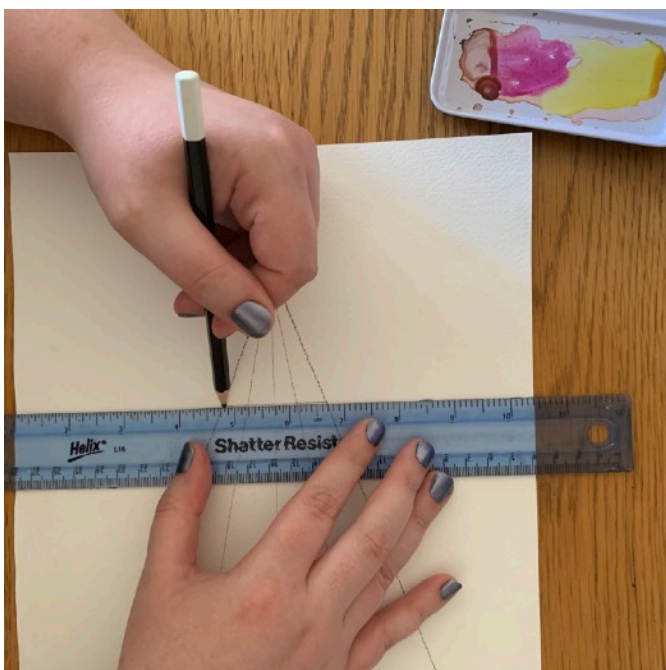
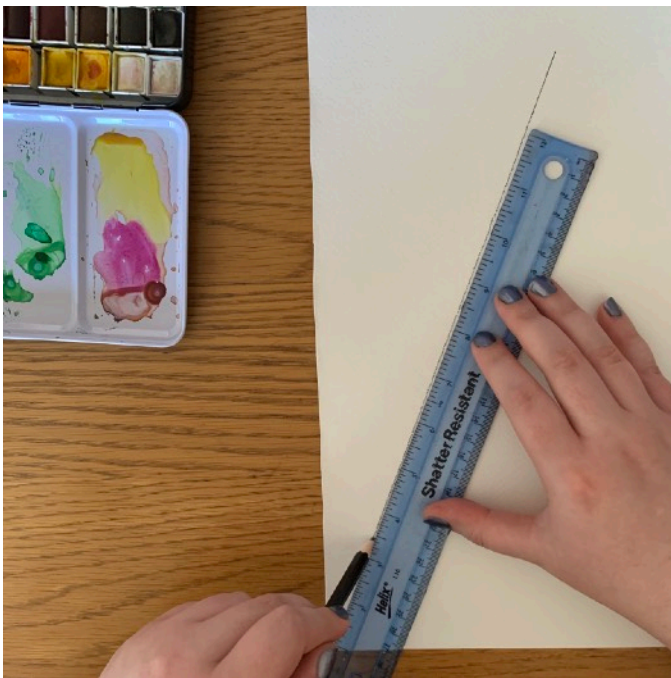
Looking at the Swedish Artist Hilma af Klint and her geometric artworks why not create one in her style!

Tools and Materials:

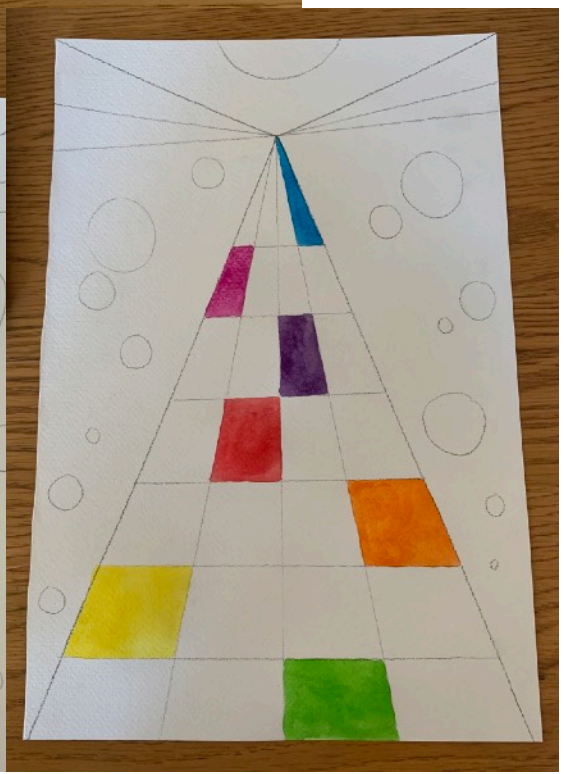
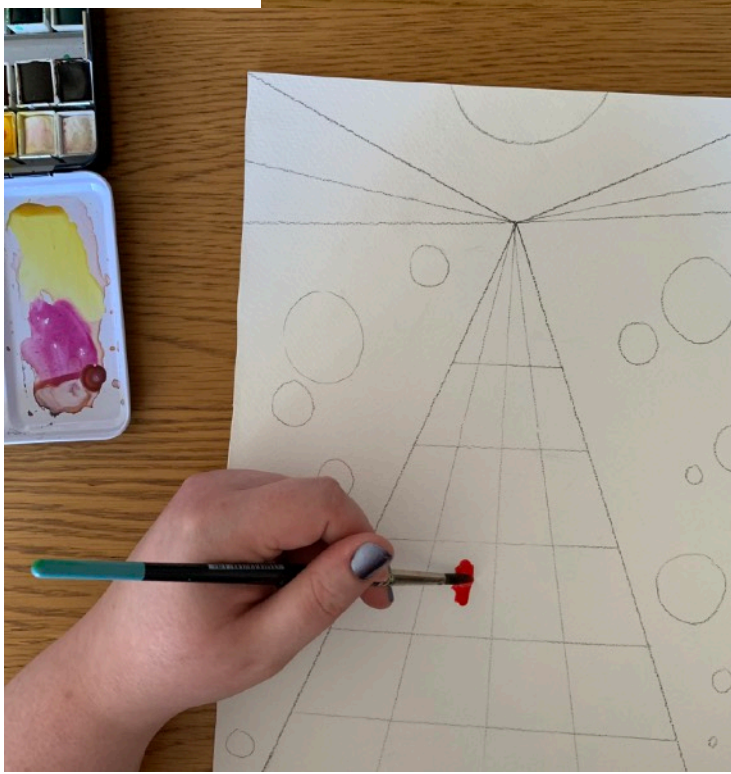
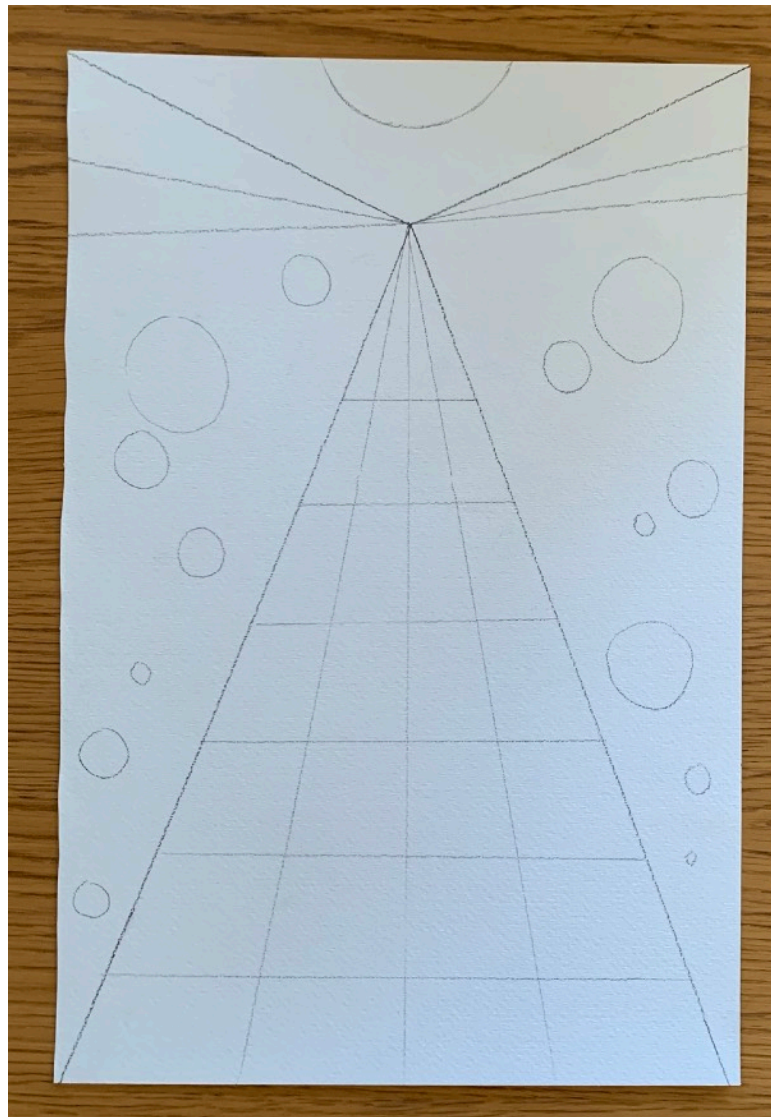
- Paper
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Watercolour
- Paintbrush
- Water



It is worth looking at her images on the internet she has many different pieces of artwork but there are often reoccurring themes - we chose to create a triangle influenced artwork. Much like strains or a path leading somewhere. Using your ruler mark out the lines for your triangles and you can separate them into smaller shapes. There is no right or wrong for this, you can also use other geometric shapes in your composition!



Once you are happy with your drawing you can then think about adding colour. We used watercolour but you can use any materials you have to hand!
