

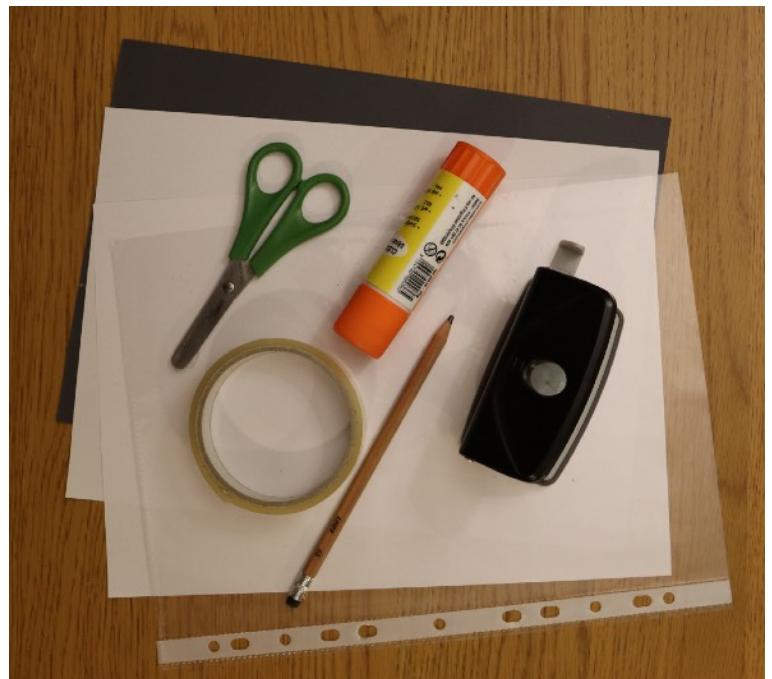
Paper Snow Globe



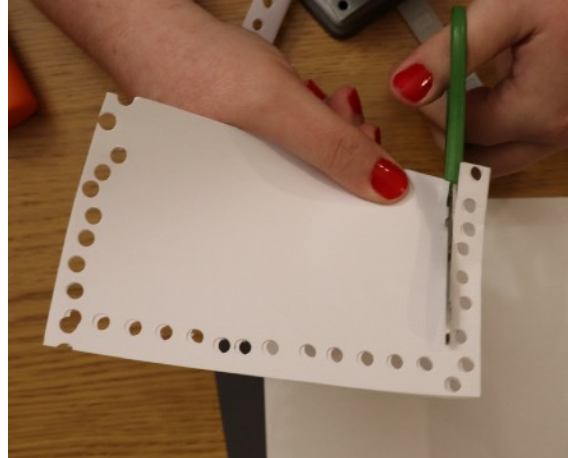
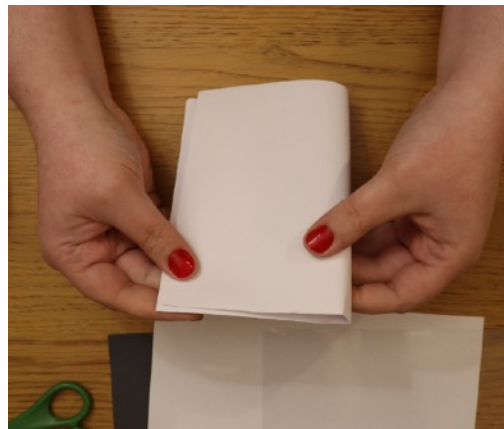
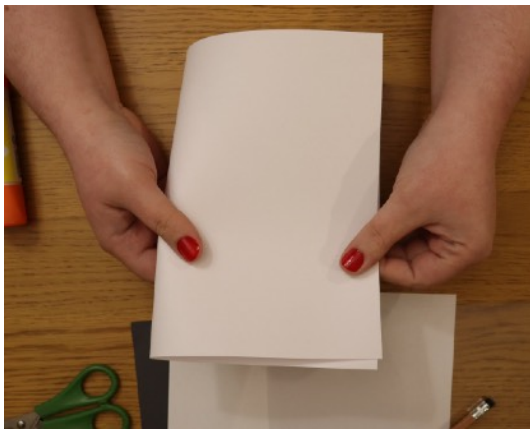
This simple craft mean you can create your own snow globe from paper - festive fun for all the family!

Tools and Materials:

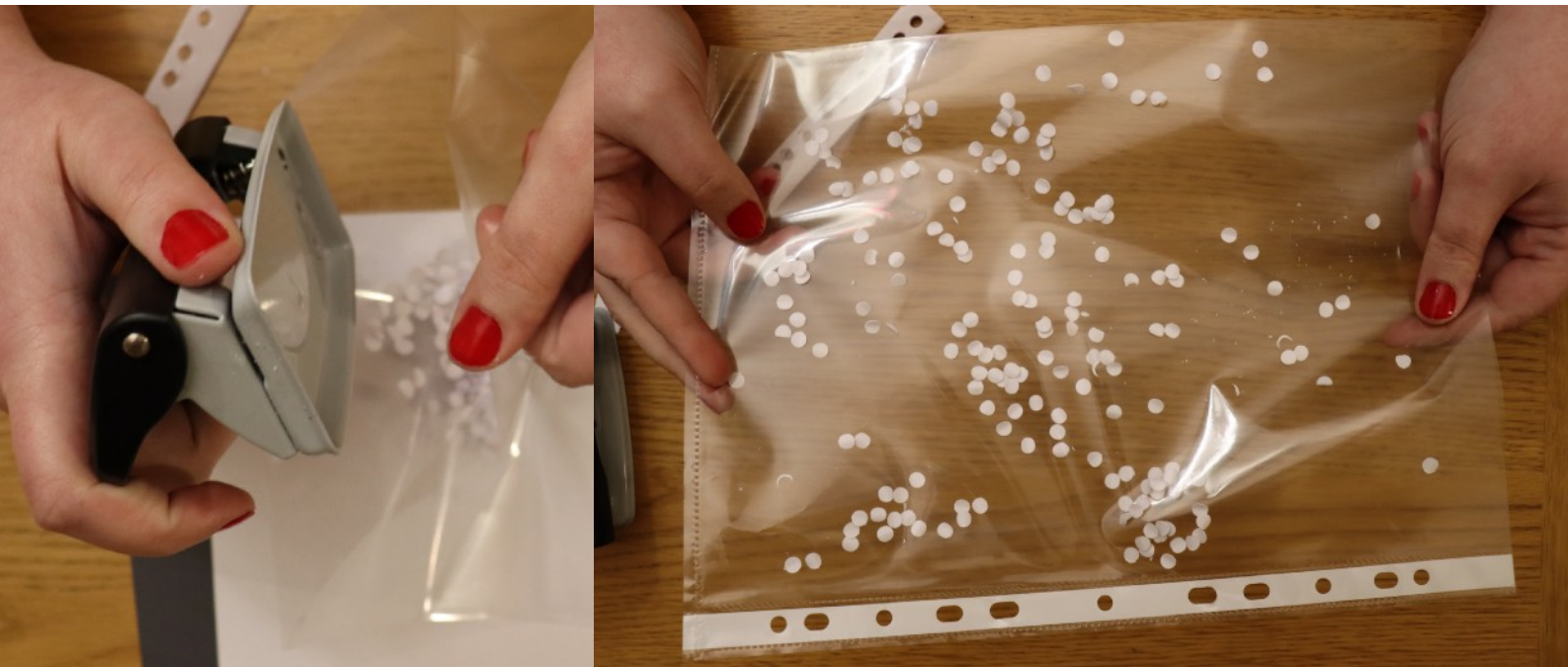
- 2 sheets White Paper + 1 sheet of Dark Paper (Blue, Purple or Black etc)
- Pencil
- Gluestick
- Scissors
- Sellotape
- Hole Punch (if you don't have one you can use scissors)
- Plastic Pocket



First of all we are going to make the snow - don't worry if you don't have a hole punch you can always snip the paper into little confetti like bits. If you do have a hole punch though fold the paper in half and then half again so you can get 4x the snow with one hole punch, trim the edge off when you have gone around so you can get more snow - keep going until you have as much snow as you want!



Once you have finished creating your snow then add it in to the plastic pocket, then put to one side



Now to create a snowy silhouette, we thought an outdoor scene at night of a snowy cabin and fir trees would be fun. Start sketching your design thinking about what bits could be cut out for contrast



Start cutting out your design when you are happy with it - don't worry about lines you don't like as you can flip the paper over so they don't show when you glue it!



Start glueing the white paper to the black - but the glue on the white paper side which has the pencil marks on, you might want to put down newspaper as the whole thing needs to be covered in glue



Once you are happy with it trim off the white side of the plastic pocket to put it in a ring binder like so. Then slide the artwork into the plastic pocket - if any snow gets stuck behind then take the snow out and move it to the front



When you are happy with your creation get some sellotape to run all along the top of the pocket to cover the whole of the open part and fold it over to keep your snow in!



There you have it your very own Paper Snow Globe!
