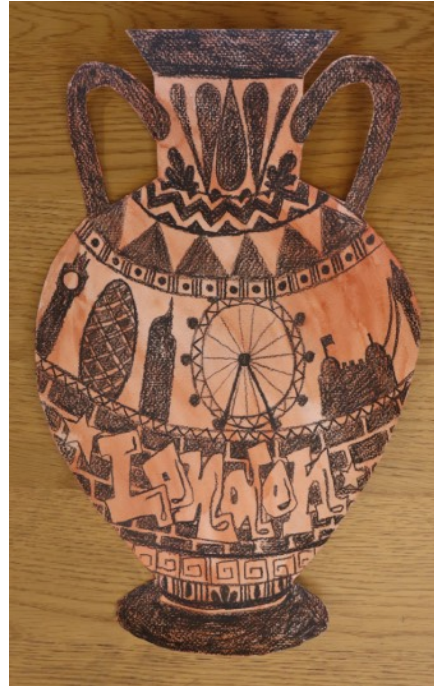


# World Museum Day



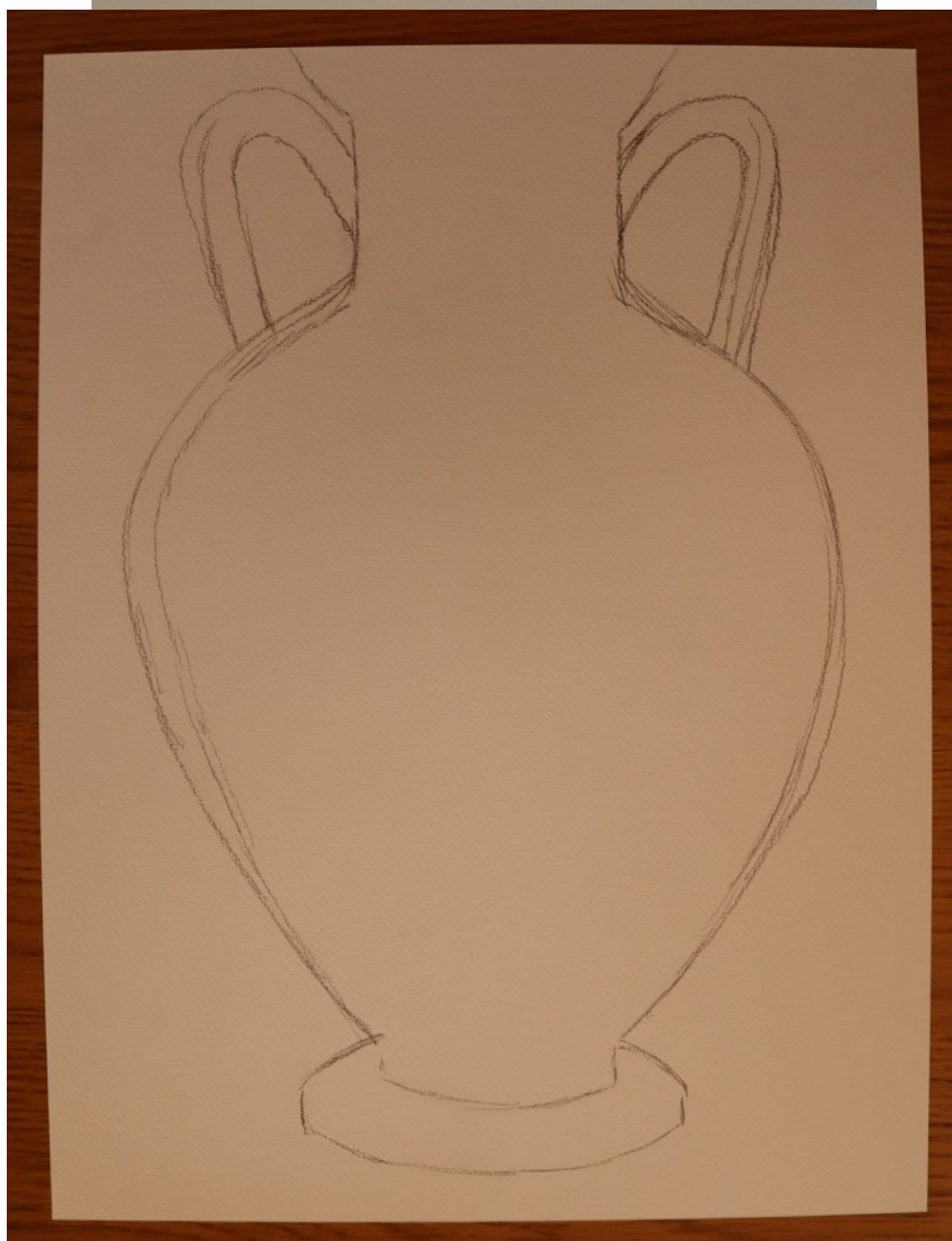
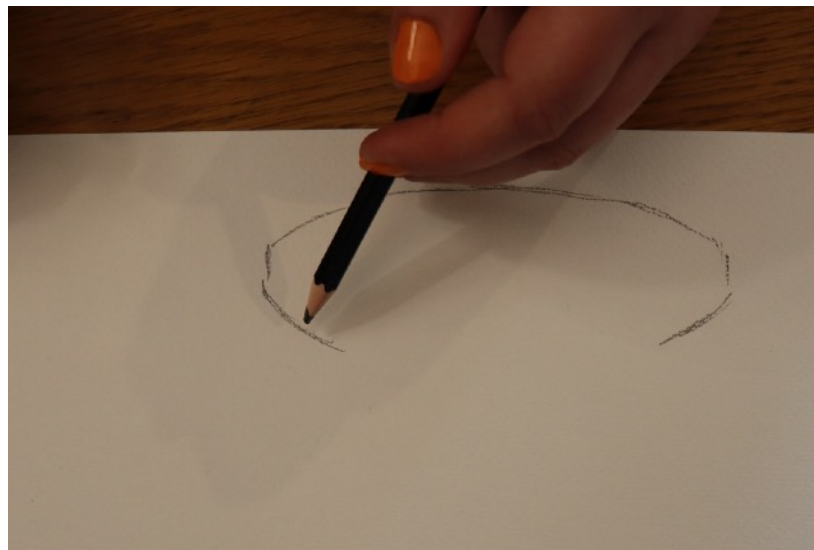
Taking inspiration from the Greek Vases in the British Museum we thought it would be fun to create contemporary version to celebrate World Museum Day which usually take place on the the18th May

## Tools and Materials:

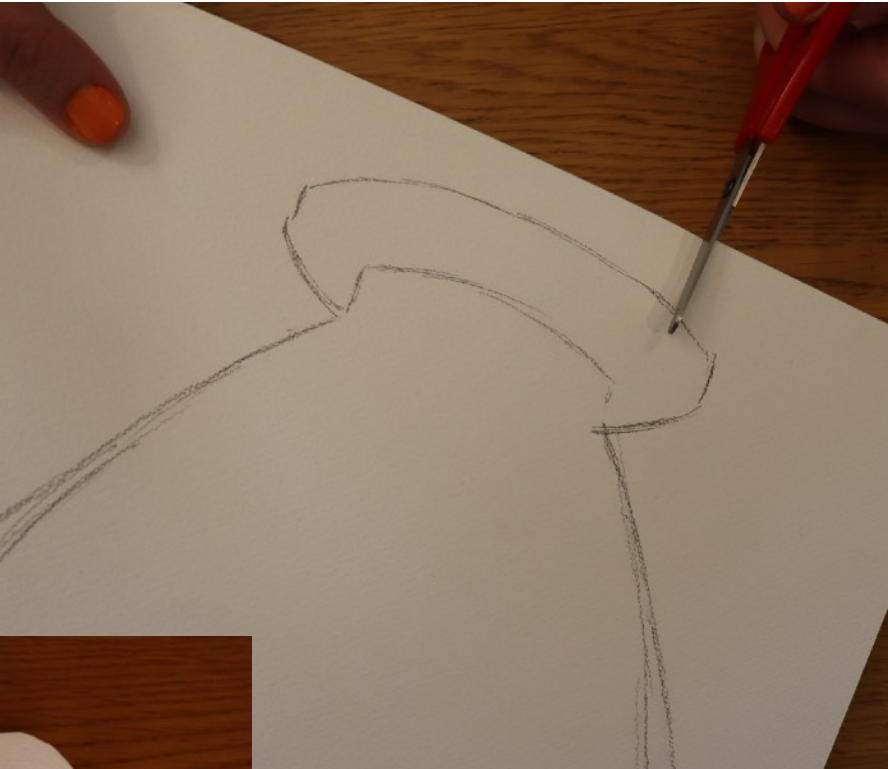
- Paper
- Pencil
- Black Colouring Pencil
- Scissors
- Paintbrush
- Watercolours
- Water



First of all start sketching out your vase - there are different traditional shapes so you might want to research reference images to help you!



Don't worry if you have lines where you don't want them because once you cut it out you can use the other side like so



Now onto the painting - because we want to do a terracotta style pot we mixed a reddish brown to cover the vase in watercolour and then let it dry



Once it is dry you can use the black colouring pencil to add your design and patterns, this one had a Modern London theme - but you can choose anything you like!



There you have it your very own “World Museum Day” artwork, you can take inspiration from anything from any Museum to create something to celebrate it!
