

Matisse Inspired Spring Collage



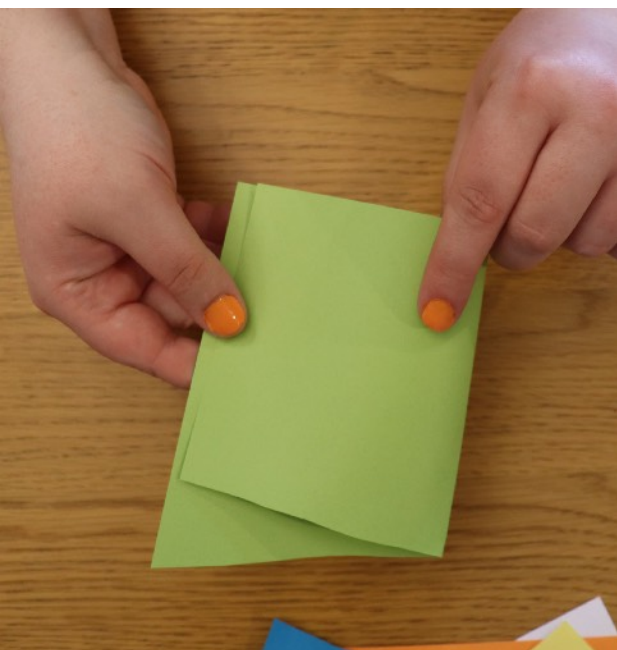
Taking inspiration from Matisse and his paper collages why not create your own slightly abstract paper cutouts celebrating spring!

Tools and Materials:

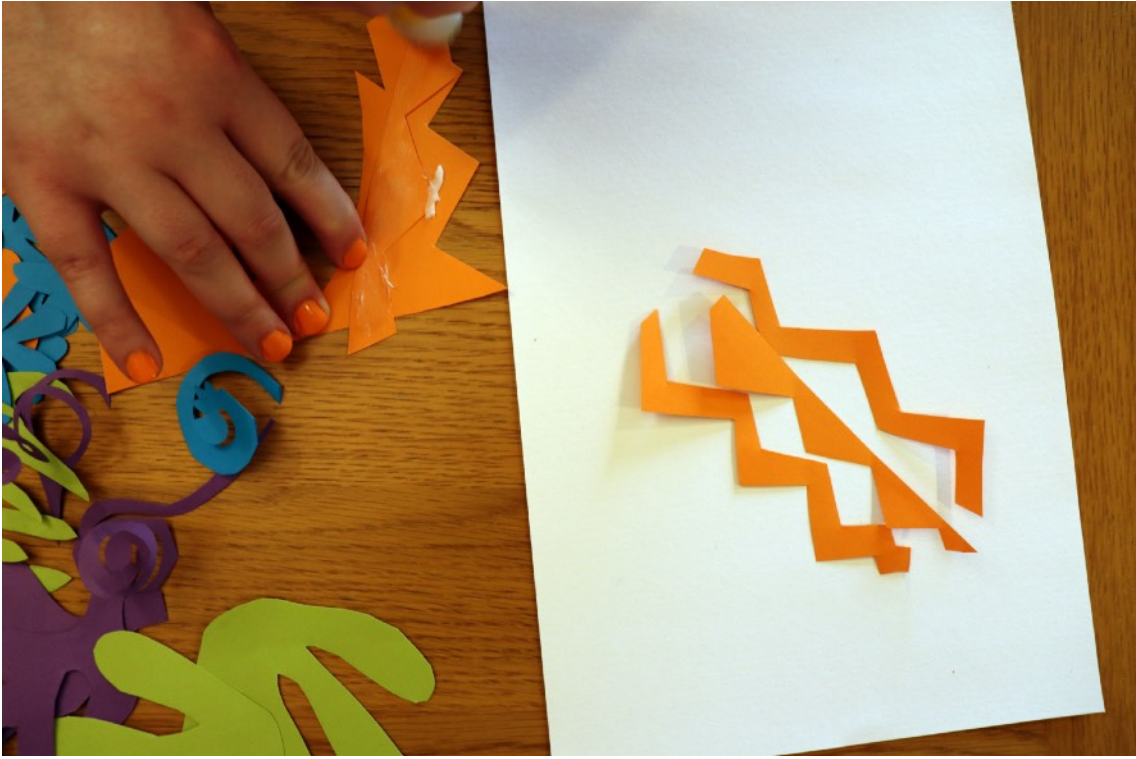
- A4 White Paper
- Scrap Coloured Paper
- Scissors
- Glue



Using your white paper as your background start cutting out shapes, we didn't use pencils to draw shapes so we could let loose and just use our imagination. The good thing about an abstract collage there is no right or wrong - the shapes can be made into what you want. Spiky shapes, curvy shapes, shapes that are made up or shapes that look like shapes you know. If you fold your paper you can create multiples of the same shape which can be good to repeat a pattern.



Once you have cut out all your shapes then start arranging them on the page to see how they look together, when you are happy you can start gluing them down
