

Watercolour & Salt



There are different things we can add to Watercolour to change how it functions - salt added to watercolour can change its flow which is fun to play about with!

Tools and Materials:

- Paper
- Watercolour
- Water
- Paintbrush
- Salt



So for this we thought it would be fun to do a wintery scene in vibrant blues and purples. First of all wet the whole paper with water on the paintbrush. You wanted to do this that when you put the watercolour on it spreads in a fluid way. Speed is of the essence because you don't want the water on the paper to dry before you put the paint on!



Whilst the water and paint is still wet sprinkle salt over the page - the salt will suck up the moisture changing how it lays on the page like so



You can paint your image whilst it is still wet but be aware it might smudge, depending on what you want to create you might want to wait for it to dry



There you have it your very own
“Watercolour & Salt” painting!
